



Is it a school with a parish, or is it a parish with a school?

It is a question I always consider when people ask me about Catholic Schools Week, though you might look at that opening question and ask, "What?"



It is a good question, because our parish communities have a mandate from the Gospel to preach the good news. Moreover, that is exactly what a good Catholic school does. It is another one of the ministries of a parish: to educate well-rounded individuals in Gospel values, preparing those young individuals to take their eventual place in the larger secular community. All the educational efforts of the parish school are focused on the life of faith. That faith is formed in knowledge of the teachings of the Church and of the Gospel, and those qualities are demonstrated through a life of service to the community.

A Catholic school is a community of faith, knowledge, and service, as a ministry of the parish community; and Catholic Schools Week provides a wonderful opportunity for us to reflect on whether we have "a school with a parish, or a parish with a school," and make sure our parish school is living its mandate from the Church.

Dear God, help us to remember especially this week that each of us is called to be holy by living our lives with love and bearing witness to Jesus in everything that we do each day. May we learn to not be afraid to be Saints, not in a distant way but right now in the present in the classroom, the playground and in our home. May we always listen to the Holy Spirit to guide and inspire us on our journey to true Holiness with you. Amen

ST. JOHN BOSCO



St. John Bosco is often referred to as Don Bosco. Don Bosco was a man of bold courage. He was the instrument that God used to found a religious family dedicated not only to helping and educating the young and the disadvantaged but to journeying with them towards heaven.

Am I using my God-given ability to dream? What dream is God inviting me to pursue at this time in my life?

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading:

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; (**Is 9:1**)



Psalm:

The Lord is my light and my salvation. (**Ps 27**)

Second Reading:

I urge you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree in what you say, and that you be united in the same mind and in the same purpose. (**1 Cor 1:10**)

Gospel:

He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled. (**Mt 4:13-14**)

GOSPEL MEDITATION - Matthew 4:12-23

I was 22 years old, lying in bed one night while on a pilgrimage, when I suddenly sensed an idea in my mind: "Go to the seminary." There was no voice, no vision, but a gentle and unmistakable clarity. I simply prayed, "Lord, if that's from you, let me find great joy in it." Three days later, my heart was bursting with joy. I dropped everything and entered the seminary. The older I get, the stranger my rather careless and hasty departure seems to me. I followed not because it made sense, or because I was especially brave. I went because the Lord called me.

Something like this happens in today's Gospel. Jesus walks by Simon, Andrew, James, and John and says, "**Come after me**" (**Matthew 4:19**). And immediately they leave their nets and follow. There's no explanation, no hesitation ... just movement. Why? As St. John says, "**In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us**" (**1 John 4:10**). They do not leave their nets because his call made perfect, calculable sense. They left them because they were called. And Jesus' call is powerful.

Take a moment this week to remember when Christ first called you. However small or quiet it was, recall it, and give thanks. The more we marvel that Christ has called us personally, the more passionately and freely we will follow him.

Mass Intention Requests

Please be considerate of others when requesting Mass Intentions: Many parishioners experience sudden loss or are in need of healing and spiritual support and cannot get a mass intention because the calendar is full. To ensure everyone has an opportunity, please:

Share weekend Masses: Request weekday Masses instead of always taking the popular Sunday/Holy Day slots so others can also have family members remembered at special times.

Limit intentions per Mass: Stick to one person, couple, or family per Mass to share the opportunity with the wider parish community.

Be flexible: Understand that a requested date might not always be possible due to priest availability or other needs, and be open to the next available date.

Prioritize needs: Remember the spiritual benefit of a Mass is infinite; a weekday Mass is just as powerful as a Sunday Mass, so allow others to have their special requests honored.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO
Mateo 4:12-23

En Jesús se cumplen todas las promesas de Dios. Las palabras de Isaías en la primera lectura nos lo dicen: *"El pueblo que habitaba en las tinieblas vio surgir una luz brillante"*. El gozo se multiplicó y la alegría aumentó. La razón de la alegría del pueblo es sencilla: se rompió el yugo que los oprimía. Experimentar la libertad es algo maravilloso, y se puede gozar de muchas formas: desde una enfermedad, a quedar sano; de estar encarcelado, y ser puesto en libertad; de relaciones no buenas, a romper con ellas. En fin, existen muchos ejemplos. Pero hay uno que debemos seguir muy de cerca: *"La gente que vivía en la oscuridad ha visto una luz muy grande; una luz que ha brillado para los que viven en lugares de sombras de muerte"* (Mateo 4:16).

¿En nuestra vida, cuáles son los lugares de sombra y de muerte? ¿Dónde debe entrar la luz que ilumine nuestra existencia? La conversión del corazón debe ser la guía que oriente el timón de nuestra vida. San Pablo nos indica una de tantas direcciones: que no haya divisiones entre nosotros, sino, por el contrario, que exista concordia entre las familias y la comunidad. Claramente nos recuerda que pertenecemos a Cristo. La clave está en saber vivir de acuerdo con el Evangelio. El Papa León XIV nos ofrece pautas seguras para llegar a Cristo: *"Ayúdense los unos a los otros a construir puentes con el diálogo, con el encuentro, uniéndonos todos para ser un solo pueblo, siempre en paz"*. *"La humanidad necesita de Él como puente para ser alcanzada por Dios, por su amor"*.


