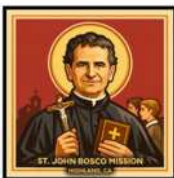

Epiphany Blessing

The Epiphany household blessing is an ancient practice in the Church. This tradition is a beautiful way to observe the coming of the magi while invoking God's blessing on your home and all who enter it. All that is needed is chalk and a prayerful heart!

Epiphany Blessing, Explained The Epiphany household blessing is a centuries-old tradition that invokes God's blessing on all who enter one's home.

All you need for an Epiphany blessing is chalk, which is usually made available by parishes either on the feast of the Epiphany or in the weeks leading up to it. There are a few different formulas for blessings out there, but the essence of the ritual is always the same: a priest or the head of the household calls down God's blessing on the house and everyone who comes into it, and an inscription is made above the door in chalk.

The inscription reads: the first two digits of the year + C + M + B + the last two digits of the year. The initials C, M and B represent the names of the magi — Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar — and also signify the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*:

"May Christ bless the house."

Mini reflection: Of all the stars you could follow, which one does the voice — that one deep within you — tell you to chase? Point to it. And go forth.



The Stars We Follow

Everyone follows a star.

It is human nature to seek. If we are rich, we want to be richer. If we are smart, we want to be smarter. If we are powerful, we want to be more powerful.

We cannot stay in one place, so to speak — to say, "I am what I am, I have what I have, and it is enough." Even the very act of maintaining a status quo, be it health or wealth or spiritual goodness, requires action. It requires effort. It requires movement. This is human nature. There is nothing wrong with it. When we stop seeking, we die.

But what are we looking for? Where are we going?

I often wonder if the Magi knew what they were seeking — really, truly knew. They were seeking "the newborn king of the Jews," yes, but did they understand who he was? What he was? I don't see how they could have. They were wise men, but they were not prophets. They simply knew this was an endeavor they had to undertake. They knew it in their souls.

There really is very little that we know for certain about the Magi. We don't know how many of them there were. We don't know their religion. We don't know where they came from. All we know for certain is that they listened to a voice they heard deep within themselves. And, heeding that voice, they went forth.

And what did they find? They found what we all seek, even if, foolishly, we seek it in riches or power.

They found the face of the Child.

So tell me this. Of all the stars you could follow, which one does the voice — that one deep within you — tell you to chase?

Point to it. And go forth.

The virtue of love seeks the good of the other, a reflection of the love of God who created us for this very purpose. In practicing this virtue, we express the fullness of our identities as sons and daughters of God. In true Christian love, we find freedom.

Mass Intention Requests

Please be considerate of others when requesting Mass Intentions: Many parishioners experience sudden loss or are in need of healing and spiritual support and cannot get a mass intention because the calendar is full.

To ensure everyone has an opportunity, please:

Share weekend Masses: Request weekday Masses instead of always taking the popular Sunday/Holy Day slots so others can also have family members remembered at special times.

Limit intentions per Mass: Stick to one person, couple, or family per Mass to share the opportunity with the wider parish community.

Be flexible: Understand that a requested date might not always be possible due to priest availability or other needs, and be open to the next available date.

Prioritize needs: Remember the spiritual benefit of a Mass is infinite; a weekday Mass is just as powerful as a Sunday Mass, so allow others to have their special requests honored.

St. Adelaide Catholic Church Mass Intentions

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful and meaningful part of our Catholic tradition. In our Parish, there are many requests for scheduling such Mass intentions. St. Adelaide has only a certain amount of Mass intention opportunities. The following policies are implemented in order to accommodate for numerous requests in a reasonable and fair manner.

Please note the following guidelines for Mass intention requests:

1. Masses may only be scheduled up to **3 months** in advance from date of request.
2. Requests will be honored on a first-come, first-serve basis in the order in which the request is received in the Parish Office.
3. Mass intentions will **not** be taken over the telephone at the Parish Office. Requests for Mass intentions may be requested **in person** in the Parish Office. A \$10 stipend, as determined by diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass request before it can be recorded in the Mass Intention Book.
4. Mass intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays and weekdays throughout the year.
5. One Mass every Sunday must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as “Pro Populo” (For the People) as required by Canon Law and diocesan statute.
6. **SPECIAL DAYS:** Mass intentions **cannot** be scheduled for:
 - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter, and Christmas when the intentions are all “Pro Populo.”
 - Mothers’ Day – Intention is for “all mothers of the parish, living and deceased.”
 - Father’s Day – Intention is for “all fathers of the parish, living and deceased.”
 - All Souls’ Day (November 2) – Intention is for “all the faithful departed.”
7. If for an unforeseen circumstance a Mass cancellation occurs, the intention for the Mass will be rescheduled on the next available opening.

Intenciones de las Misas



Iglesia Católica Santa Adelaida Política de Intenciones de Misa

La práctica de solicitar que se ofrezca una Misa por seres queridos, vivos o difuntos, es una parte hermosa y significativa de nuestra tradición católica. En nuestra parroquia hay muchas solicitudes de intenciones de Misa; sin embargo, la Iglesia de Santa Adelaida cuenta con un número limitado de oportunidades para intenciones de Misa. Las siguientes políticas se implementan para acomodar las solicitudes de manera justa y razonable.

Por favor tome en cuenta las siguientes normas para solicitar intenciones de Misa:

1. Las Misas pueden programarse **hasta con tres (3) meses de anticipación** a partir de la fecha de la solicitud.
2. Las solicitudes se atenderán por **orden de llegada**, según se reciban en la Oficina Parroquial.
3. **No se aceptarán solicitudes de intenciones de Misa por teléfono.** Las solicitudes deben hacerse en persona en la Oficina Parroquial.
 - Se requiere un estipendio de \$10 por Misa, conforme a la política diocesana, para que la solicitud sea registrada en el Libro de Intenciones de Misa.
4. Las intenciones de Misa pueden solicitarse para domingos, la mayoría de los días festivos y días entre semana durante el año.
5. **Una Misa cada domingo** debe programarse por las intenciones de nuestros feligreses, conocida como **“Pro Populo” (Por el Pueblo)**, según lo exige el Derecho Canónico y el estatuto diocesano.
6. **Días especiales:** No se pueden programar intenciones de Misa en los siguientes días:
 - **Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo, Pascua y Navidad** (todas las intenciones son Pro Populo)
 - **Día de las Madres** – Intención por todas las madres de la parroquia, vivas y difuntas
 - **Día de los Padres** – Intención por todos los padres de la parroquia, vivos y difuntos
 - **Día de los Fieles Difuntos** (2 de noviembre) – Intención por todos los fieles difuntos

7. En caso de una **cancelación imprevista de Misa**, la intención será reprogramada en el **próximo espacio disponible**.

Solicitudes de Intenciones de Misa

Por favor, sea considerado con los demás al solicitar Intenciones de Misa: muchos feligreses experimentan pérdidas repentinas o necesitan sanación y apoyo espiritual, y a veces no pueden obtener una intención de Misa porque el calendario está lleno. Para asegurar que todos tengan la oportunidad:

- **Comparta las Misas de fin de semana:** Solicite Misas entre semana en lugar de ocupar siempre los horarios populares de domingo o días de precepto, para que otros también puedan recordar a sus seres queridos en momentos especiales.
- **Limite las intenciones por Misa:** Manténgase en una persona, pareja o familia por Misa, para compartir esta oportunidad con toda la comunidad parroquial.
- **Sea flexible:** Comprenda que la fecha solicitada puede no ser siempre posible debido a la disponibilidad del sacerdote u otras necesidades, y esté dispuesto a aceptar la siguiente fecha disponible.
- **Priorice las necesidades:** Recuerde que el beneficio espiritual de una Misa es infinito; una Misa entre semana es tan poderosa como una Misa dominical. Permita que otros también puedan ver honradas sus solicitudes especiales.

Bendición de la Epifanía

Mini Explicación — La bendición del hogar de la Epifanía es una práctica antigua en la Iglesia. Esta tradición es una hermosa manera de observar la venida de los reyes magos mientras invocas la bendición de Dios sobre tu hogar y todos los que entran en él. ¡Todo lo que se necesita es tiza y un corazón lleno de oración!



Bendición de la Epifanía, Explicada La bendición del hogar de la Epifanía es una tradición centenaria que invoca la bendición de Dios sobre todos los que entran en nuestra casa.

Todo lo que se necesita para una bendición de la Epifanía es tiza, que generalmente está disponible en las parroquias en la fiesta de la Epifanía o en las semanas previas a ella. Existen algunas fórmulas diferentes para las bendiciones, pero la esencia del ritual es siempre la misma: un sacerdote o la cabeza de familia invoca la bendición de Dios sobre la casa y todos los que entran en ella, y se hace una inscripción sobre la puerta con tiza.

La inscripción dice: los dos primeros dígitos del año + C + M + B + los dos últimos dígitos del año. Las iniciales C, M y B representan los nombres de los reyes magos: Gaspar, Melchor y Baltasar, y también significan la frase latina *Christus mansionem benedicat*:

"Que Cristo bendiga la casa".
