

THE FIRST DAY OF LENT

In the Roman Catholic Church, Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, the season of preparation for the resurrection of Jesus. While Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but all Roman Catholics are encouraged to attend Mass on this day in order to mark the beginning of the Lenten Season.

The Distribution of Ashes

During Mass, the ashes which give Ash Wednesday its name are distributed. The ashes are made by burning the blessed palms that were distributed the previous year on Palm Sunday. After the priest blesses the ashes and sprinkles them with holy water, the faithful come forward to receive them. The priest dips his right thumb in the ashes and making the Sign of the Cross on each person's forehead, says, "Repent and believe in the gospel" (or a variation of these words).

A Day of Remembrance

The distribution of ashes reminds us of our own mortality and calls us to repentance. In the early Church, Ash Wednesday was the day on which those who had sinned, and who wished to be readmitted to the Church, would begin their public penance. The ashes that we receive are a reminder of our own sinfulness, and many Catholics leave them on their foreheads all day as a sign of humility.

Fasting and Abstinence

The Church emphasizes the penitential nature of Ash Wednesday by calling us to fast and abstain from meat. Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller ones during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating any meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday.

Taking Stock of our Spiritual Lives

This fasting and abstinence is not simply a form of penance, however, it is also a call for us to take stock of our spiritual lives. As Lent begins, we should set specific goals we would like to reach before Easter and decide how we will pursue them for instance, by going to Mass daily when we can and receiving the Sacrament of Confession more often.

In 1997, several parents of LGBTQ adult children approached Bishop Gerald Barnes and expressed their anguish and concern for their children. For most parents, it was a shock when their child came out to them. Some felt sad, confused, angry, disappointed or scared for their child's safety and salvation. To give parents a place to support one another and talk about their concerns, Bishop Barnes created the diocesan commission for ministry to families with gay and lesbian children, and a ministry for these families began. For almost 30 years this diocesan commission and ministry - now called Embrace - has continued.

Today Embrace meetings for parents of LGBTQ children take place every other month at St. John Bosco Parish in Highland and at St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish in Riverside. There is even an Embrace meeting only for permanent deacons and their wives because they have unique concerns as clergy leaders in their parish.

In addition to Embrace meetings for parents and relatives, there is also a parish-based ministry - named Gifted and Called - for LGBTQ Catholics. Ministry for families with LGBTQ children and for LGBTQ Catholic themselves is born in large part from everyone's desire to keep all Catholics in the Church and coming to Mass, especially those who feel excluded, unwelcome, and on the margins. Jesus gave additional time and special care to the one lost sheep, for the one looked down upon, and for those outside the community. Parishes offer ministries tailored to specific communities (for example, the bereaved, men only, youth and young adults, a certain language and culture) in order for them to share faith with others who share similar experiences and are going through the same issues.

Embrace meetings consist of prayer, faith sharing, scripture, and the sharing of the experiences and feelings as parents, whatever they may be. We try to offer unconditional support for parents as they navigate the coming out experience of their child. Each family is unique, but no one needs to go through these times alone.


