

THE DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

The Divine Mercy Novena, requested by Jesus through St. Faustina, is aimed at bringing souls to the "Fount of His Mercy". It features daily intentions for specific groups, such as "The souls who are detained in purgatory to immerse them in the abyss of My Great Mercy". In this vicariate, the novena will be prayed at a different church each day, leading up to the Great Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12.

The Journey to Divine Mercy Continues...

The beautiful feast of **Divine Mercy Sunday** is **April 12**. The Church invites us to prepare our hearts to receive the extraordinary graces Jesus longs to pour out on our world.

Please consider practicing acts of mercy leading up to this feast such as:


- forgiving those who have offended you
- praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- practicing patience and mercy toward others.

In further preparation, Jesus requires that we go to confession before Divine Mercy Sunday to receive the full promise of forgiveness of sins.

The essential requirement is that **you be in a state of Grace**—no mortal sin, and receive Holy Communion (on Divine Mercy Sunday) with the intention of obtaining the promised graces by asking Jesus directly for them. Jesus also gave one very important condition: **that you must trust in His mercy!**

Jesus promised that on that day, (Divine Mercy Sunday) the very depths of His tender mercy are opened. He will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach this feast of His mercy. On that day, **ALL** the divine floodgates through

Jesus, I trust in You.



Mass Intentions

Requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful part of our Catholic tradition. Because our parish receives many requests, the following guidelines help ensure requests are handled fairly.

— Guidelines —

- ◆ **Scheduling:** Mass intentions may be scheduled **up to 3 months** in advance.
- ◆ **Requests:** Requests are honored **first-come, first-served** in the Parish Office.
- ◆ **How to Request:** Mass intentions **cannot be taken by phone**. Requests must be made in person at the Parish Office.
A **\$10 stipend** (per diocesan policy) must accompany each request before it can be recorded in the **Mass Intention Book**.
- ◆ **Available Days:** Mass intentions may be requested for **Sundays**, most holidays, and weekdays throughout the year.

— Special Days —

Mass intentions cannot be scheduled for:

- ◆ **Holy Thursday** ◆ **Good Friday**
- ◆ **Easter** ◆ **Christmas**
- ◆ **Mother's Day** – intention for "all mothers of the parish (living & deceased)
- ◆ **Father's Day** – intention for "all fathers of the parish (living & deceased)
- ◆ **All Souls' Day** (Nov. 2) – intention for "all the faithful departed

If a Mass must be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the intention will be rescheduled for the next available date.
