





It was during the fourth century in Jerusalem that Christians first started using palm branches in commemoration of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. Today, we continue to use palms in most churches on this Sunday, Catholic and Protestant alike. It is one of those traditions of worship that, no matter how far apart we may seem at times, we continue to share due to our common heritage.

But Palm Sunday is also known as Passion Sunday, because we hear an account of the passion of Jesus Christ during the liturgy. Most churches also share this reading in common. Many Catholic parishes use multiple lectors to proclaim the Gospel, while it is not uncommon for a similar reading or even a performance in many mainstream Protestant churches.

The commonality found in the worship on this particular Sunday seems to highlight the fundamental truth in the observance: Jesus Christ died for everyone. He did not die on a cross for just Catholics, or just Orthodox, or just Protestants. Whether one acknowledges it or not, he was crucified for all those who are born of man. Today, we rejoice not just for what he has done for us but also for what he has done for all of creation.

**On the journey to Divine Mercy Sunday....**

The Divine Mercy Novena begins this week, on Friday April 3rd.

The first novena service will be held at Immaculate Conception Church, in Colton, at 3:00.

A traditional Good Friday service will also be held there that day.

Jesus revealed to St. Faustina Kowalska the depth of His love and mercy for mankind with these words:

**"I am Love and Mercy Itself. There is NO misery that could be a match for My Mercy, neither will misery exhaust it, because as it is being granted, it increases."** (Diary paragraph 1273).

**Reminder:** Please go to Confession before Divine Mercy Sunday (April 12) to receive the full promise of forgiveness of sins as promised to all sinners on that day.





## Holy Thursday FOOT WASHING



What is the significance of foot washing on Holy Thursday?


Foot washing is an ancient practice of hospitality. In Israel in Jesus' day, with its deserts and dusty roads, washing of feet was an act of honor on the part of the host. However, the host himself would not do the washing. That was the role of the servant. The Apostles would have been accustomed to this tradition.

*"This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me."* - Luke 22:19B

Holy Thursday is the commemoration of the Last Supper. We celebrate many things, including the institution of both the Eucharist and the priesthood - "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." (Luke 22:19B)

When the priest washes the feet of his parishioners, he is modeling the service of Christ.

While foot washing is no longer a common practice in our society, we too are invited to imitate Christ's sacrificial service to others.



## The Stillness of Holy Saturday

Holy Thursday brings us the Last Supper. On Good Friday, we exalt the cross and commemorate the death of Jesus. On Easter Sunday, we celebrate! But what about the day in between? Between death and life, the time holds its breath.

For the first disciples, Holy Saturday was a day of silence, sorrow, and waiting. But redemption is already beginning! Jesus descends to the dead and frees righteous souls awaiting eternal life. On our own

Holy Saturdays, we too wait in silence. But it is not the silence of disappointment and confusion. It is the silence of anticipation. Soon and very soon, dawn will alight on the horizon, and the stone will be rolled back. Until then, we wait in stillness.

## Domingo de Ramos

### Pregunta:

¿De dónde vienen las palmas del Domingo de Ramos y cómo deben usarse respetuosamente?

### Respuesta:

La celebración del Domingo de Ramos tiene orígenes antiguos. Al iniciar la liturgia "afuera" de la iglesia, recreamos de manera simbólica la entrada de Cristo a Jerusalén. Las multitudes en el antiguo Israel agitaban las ramas de palma, que eran un símbolo de realeza, para darle la bienvenida a Jesús. Hoy en día, obtener las palmas requiere de mucha planificación y coordinación, debido a que cientos de miles de iglesias de todo el mundo las necesitan el mismo día. Muchos en Estados Unidos encargan las palmas de la Florida, California, Texas o Centro América.

Las palmas que se usan en el Domingo de Ramos se bendicen en la Misa. Esto significa que las palmas no deben terminar en la basura! Mucha gente tiene que coser las palmas o las familias las exhiben durante el año. Si no planeas exhibir tus palmas durante todo el año, debes quemarlas, enterrarlas o dejarlas en la iglesia. En el último caso, las palmas que se entreguen son las que se quemarán para el servicio del Miércoles de Cenizas del próximo año.
