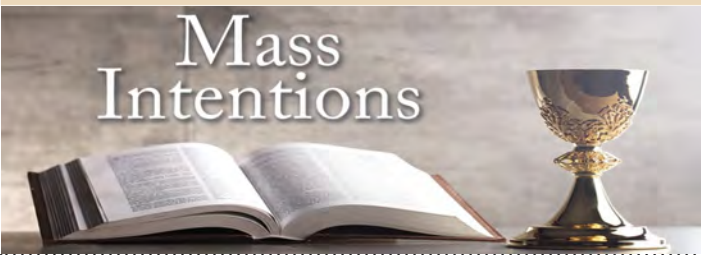

INTERESTED IN BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN UNDER 7 YEARS?

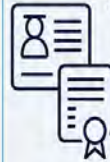
Welcome to this time of preparation for the Baptism of your child.



The process is only 3 steps.

1

Make an appointment to see the Baptism Coordinator. At that time you must bring your government identification and your child or children's birth certificate.



- During your appointment an information and contact sheet will be given to you to complete.
- The Coordinator will have a friendly conversation with you about any personal circumstances regarding your child. You may share the sacramental situation of any others in your immediate family. Depending on the direction of your conversation, you will be given contact information or resources available to your family (Marriage, Holy Communion, Confirmation, Religious Education, Retreats).
- You will be informed of the requirements for Godparents, and the importance of their role, and how to submit any of their documents.
- You will be informed of the required Baptism Preparation Course, and how and when to register.

Next, Parents and Godparents attend a 90 minute, Thursday evening, Baptism Preparation Course, at St. Adelaide. (English & Spanish available)



- Appreciation of Baptism comes in part from understanding; so the first presentation will be an overview of the Theology of the Sacrament of Baptism.
- In order to ensure active participation in the Baptismal Rite, the second presentation will be a walk through the Rite at St. Adelaide or Saint John Bosco.
- The final session is important for prayer, reflection, and discussion on how we can live out our lives, and the lives of our children.

Once all is documented and completed, your child will be scheduled for a Saturday Baptism.



Baptisms are generally scheduled for once a month, at the end of the month, except during Lent, and the Christmas season.

**GOSPEL MEDITATION -
 5th Sunday of Easter
 John 14:1-12**



We generally approach life with the question, “What can this do for me?” We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I’ll eventually reap some benefit, or I won’t do it. It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful? But in today’s Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn’t present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, **“I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.”** (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life. Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart — love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings — is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive. The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God’s own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results — it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.

Mass Intention Requests

Please be considerate of others when requesting Mass Intentions: Many parishioners experience sudden loss or are in need of healing and spiritual support and cannot get a mass intention because the calendar is full. To ensure everyone has an opportunity, please:

Share weekend Masses: Request weekday Masses instead of always taking the popular Sunday/Holy Day slots so others can also have family members remembered at special times.

Limit intentions per Mass: Stick to one person, couple, or family per Mass to share the opportunity with the wider parish community.

Be flexible: Understand that a requested date might not always be possible due to priest availability or other needs, and be open to the next available date.

Prioritize needs: Remember the spiritual benefit of a Mass is infinite; a weekday Mass is just as powerful as a Sunday Mass, so allow others to have their special requests honored.
