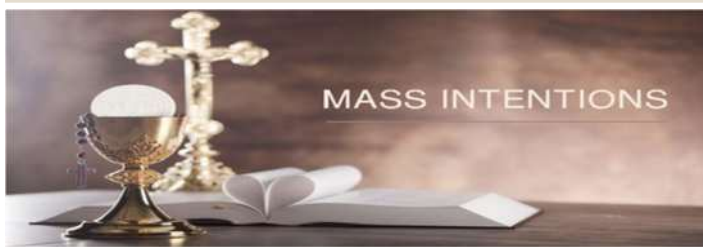

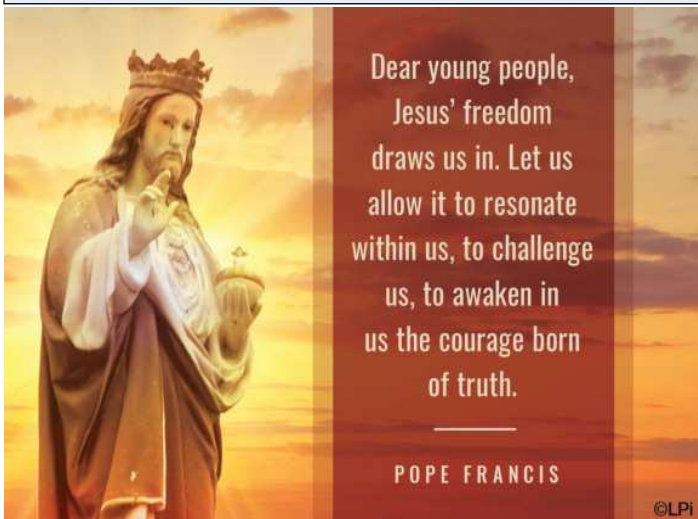

Advent Wreath, Explained!

The Advent Wreath as we know it today is a modern spin on an ancient practice — or rather, several of them.

Christians have always utilized candles to illustrate the metaphor of Christ as the “great light” shining on a people waiting in darkness (Isaiah 9:2). Historians tell us that pre-Christian societies in Europe also viewed candles as symbolic of the coming light of spring, and may have used wreaths of natural material along with these candles. Traditions and rituals surrounding an “Advent Wreath” are often thought to have originated in the Lutheran tradition in 16th-century Germany. Today, Advent Wreaths are a practice embraced by most Christians in the Western world.

An Advent Wreath consists of a circle of evergreen and four candles, one for each week of Advent. Three of the candles are purple; one is rose, representing Gaudete Sunday, a time of rejoicing at the closeness of Christmas. In Catholicism, Advent Wreaths are blessed on the First Sunday of Advent. For Advent Wreaths in private homes, it is appropriate for a family member to perform the blessing.



Join Our Beautiful Advent Tradition!
Our parish invites families to participate in a cherished custom during the Advent season. Each week leading up to Christmas, families are welcome to light the Advent wreath at the beginning of Mass.

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

(Holy Day of Obligation)
Monday, December 8th, 2025

It's important to understand what the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception is and what it is not. Some people think the term refers to Christ's conception in Mary's womb without the intervention of a human father; but that is the Virgin Birth. Others think the Immaculate Conception means Mary was conceived “by the power of the Holy Spirit,” in the way Jesus was, but that, too, is incorrect. The Immaculate Conception means that Mary, whose conception was brought about the normal way, was conceived without original sin or its stain—that's what “immaculate” means: without stain. The Immaculate Conception is a dogma of the Catholic Church maintaining that from the moment when she was conceived the Blessed Virgin Mary was kept free of original sin and was filled with the sanctifying grace normally conferred during baptism.

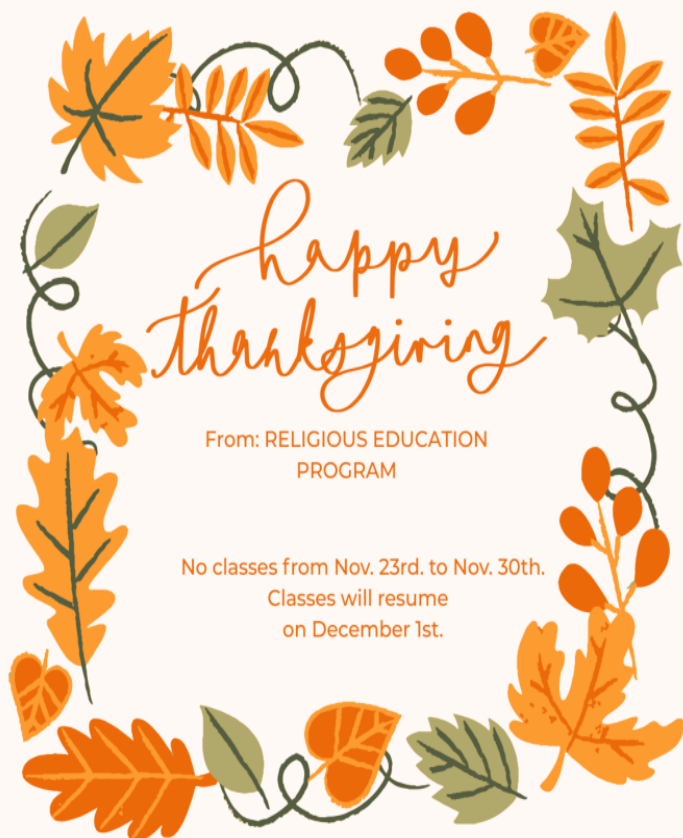

Solemnidad de la Inmaculada Concepción de la Virgen María (Día de Obligación)

Es importante comprender qué es y qué no es la doctrina de la Inmaculada Concepción. Algunas personas piensan que el término se refiere a la concepción de Cristo en el útero de María sin la intervención de un padre humano, pero ese es el nacimiento virginal. Otros piensan que la Inmaculada Concepción significa que María fue concebida "por el poder del Espíritu Santo", en la forma en que lo fue Jesús, pero eso también es incorrecto. La Inmaculada Concepción significa que María, cuya concepción se produjo de la manera normal, fue concebida sin el pecado original ni su mancha; eso es lo que significa "inmaculada": sin mancha. La esencia del pecado original consiste en la privación de la gracia santificante, y su mancha es de naturaleza corrupta. María fue preservada de estos defectos por la gracia de Dios; desde el primer instante de su existencia, se encontraba en estado de gracia santificante y estaba libre de la naturaleza corrupta que trae el pecado original. La Inmaculada Concepción es un dogma de la Iglesia Católica que sostiene que desde el momento en que fue concebida la Santísima Virgen María se mantuvo libre del pecado original y se llenó de la gracia santificante que normalmente se confiere durante el bautismo.

Corona de Adviento, ¡Explicada!

Los cristianos siempre han utilizado velas para ilustrar la metáfora de Cristo como la "gran luz" que brilla sobre un pueblo que espera en tinieblas (Isaías 9:2). Los historiadores nos dicen que las sociedades precristianas en Europa también veían las velas como un símbolo de la llegada de la luz de la primavera, y pueden haber usado coronas de material natural junto con estas velas. A menudo se cree que las tradiciones y los rituales que rodean a una "Corona de Adviento" se originaron en la tradición luterana en la Alemania del siglo XVI. Hoy en día, las Coronas de Adviento son una práctica adoptada por la mayoría de los cristianos en el mundo occidental.

Una Corona de Adviento consiste en un círculo de hojas perennes y cuatro velas, una para cada semana de Adviento. Tres de las velas son de color morado; una es rosa, que representa el domingo de Gaudete, un tiempo de regocijo por la cercanía de la Navidad. En el catolicismo, las coronas de Adviento se bendicen el primer domingo de Adviento. Para las Coronas de Adviento en casas privadas, es apropiado que un miembro de la familia realice la bendición.
