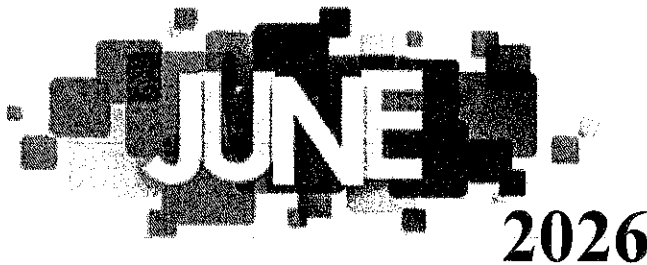

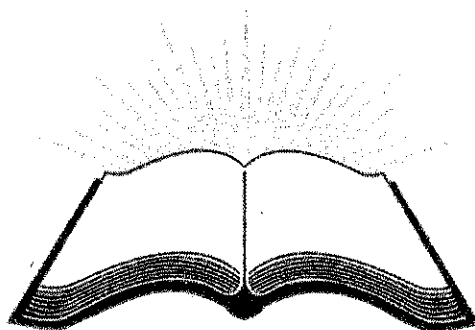

June-school's out (or almost), late sleeping in, vacation time, time with friends and not least, help parent(s) around the house (now that you have time on your hands).

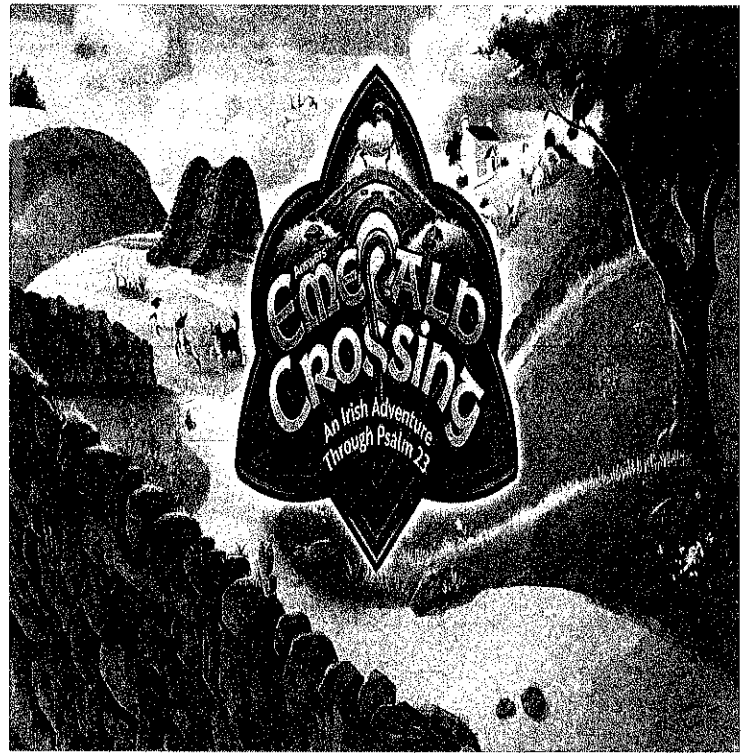

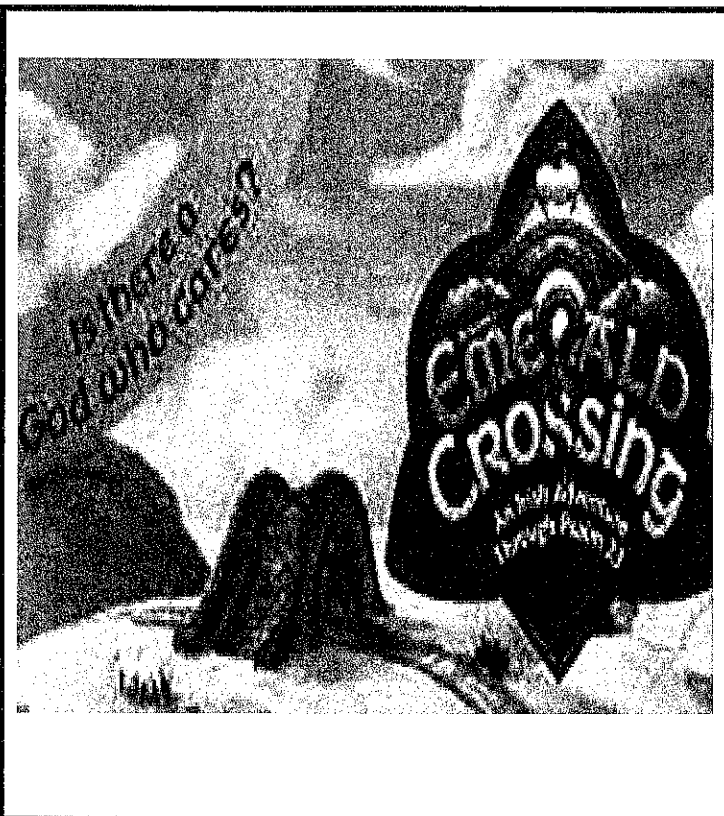
Game night will be Friday, June 26, 6:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall. We had several new gamers in May, and everyone had a great time. So come be a part of game night.

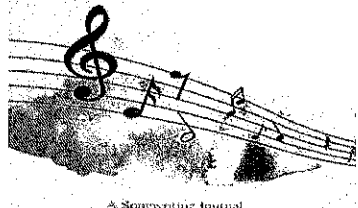

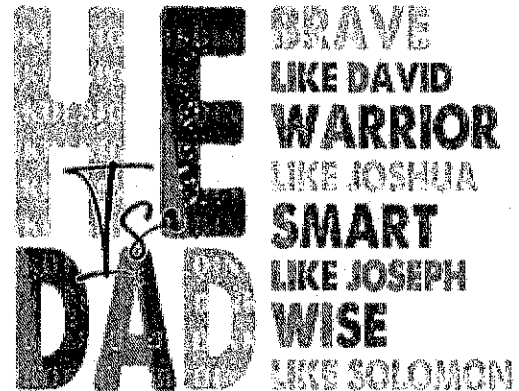
