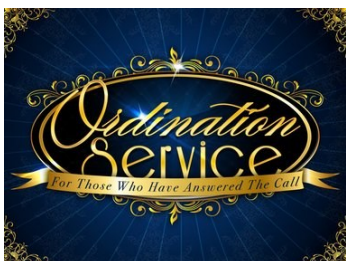
is a special, focused time of prayer for Southern Baptist missionaries serving through the International Mission Board and the people whom they serve.
