Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias

Dementia is not a single disease, rather an overall term to describe a collection of symptoms that one may experience if they are living with a variety of diseases, including Alzheimer's. Alzheimer's disease ranks as the 6th leading cause of mortality in the US (CDC) or the 7th leading cause of mortality in Kansas (CDC). Diseases grouped under the general term "dementia" are caused by abnormal brain changes. Dementia symptoms trigger a decline in thinking skills, also known as cognitive abilities, severe enough to impair daily life and independent function. They also affect behavior, feelings and relationships. In cases where a primary care physician suspects mild cognitive impairment or potential Alzheimer's disease, they may opt to refer the patient to specialists such as geriatricians, geriatric psychiatrists, neurologists, or neuropsychologists. To diagnose Alzheimer's, physicians may use medical history, mental status tests, physical and neurological exams, diagnostic tests and brain imaging.

The Alzheimer's Association 24/7 Helpline (800-272-3900) is a free service offering support for people living with dementia, caregivers, families and the public. Connect with a live person who can provide information, local resources, crisis assistance and emotional support.

The Alzheimer's Association in your area offers support groups, caregiver and healthcare professionals training, access to a video/book library, various publications and newsletters, outreach services, a safe return registry, and referral services.

K-RAD Program

The purpose is to provide relief to unpaid caregivers of individuals with a diagnosis or probable diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or related dementia.

The Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services administers the program through the Area Agencies on Aging.

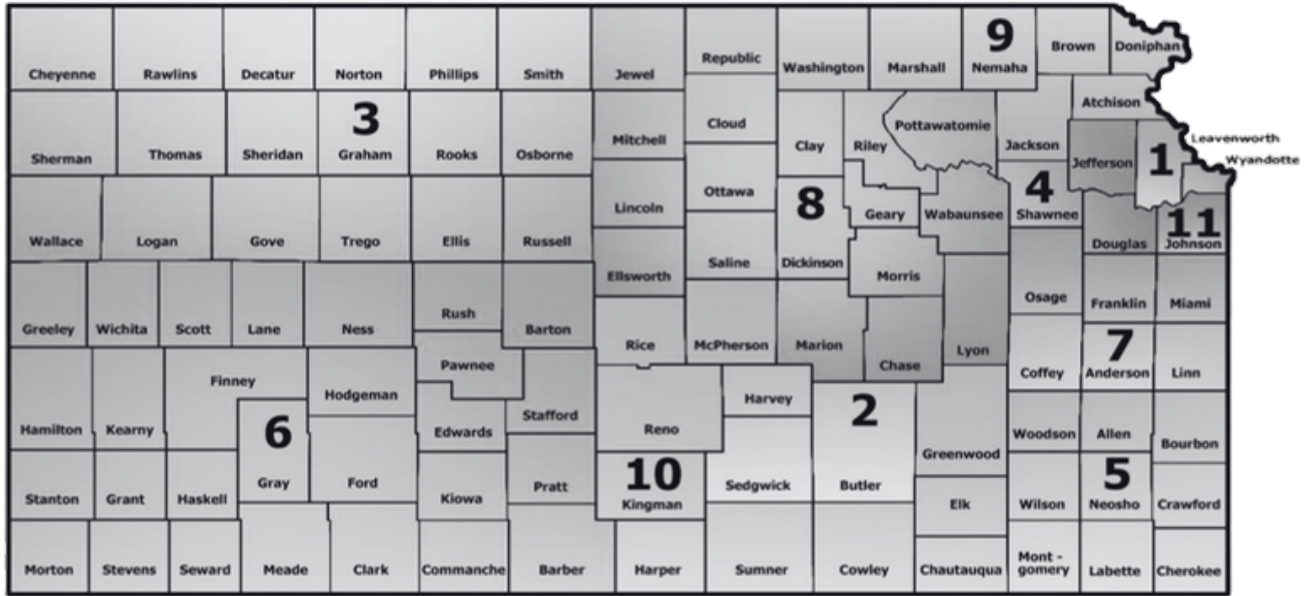

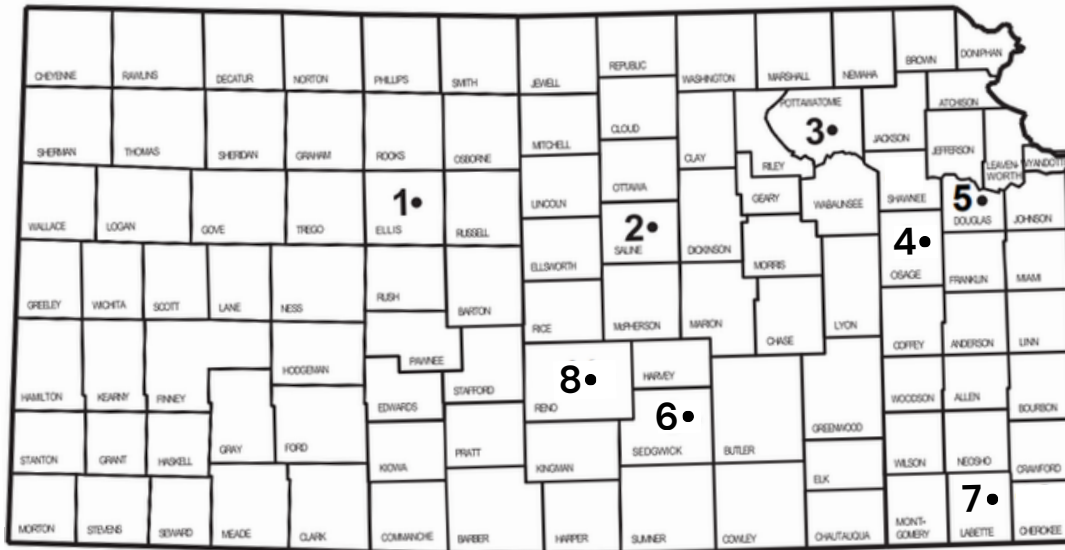

Perpetrators often employ sophisticated tactics, exploiting seniors' unfamiliarity with technology or financial intricacies. Common warning signs include unsolicited requests for personal information, pressure to act quickly, and promises of unrealistic returns. To protect against such exploitation, it's crucial for older adults to stay informed, verify the legitimacy of offers, and seek advice from trusted sources before making any financial decisions. Vigilance and awareness are key defenses in safeguarding against these harmful schemes.

Stop: Don't give out your information. Hang up the phone, don't click on buttons or links, and don't respond to messages from potential scammers.

Verify: Check if the person trying to reach you is legitimate by verifying the source. Asking for help from someone you trust, like your bank, your family, or your friends, will help to relieve some of the stress of the situation and ensure you locate the right information.

Report: If you or someone you know has been scammed or may be at risk of exploitation, call the Kansas Protection Report Center hotline at 1-800-922-5330.

Reporting scam activity helps improve efforts to shut down scams and scammers and prevent future scam victims. Financial scams are everyone's business.

How to Choose a Nursing Facility

At some point, many of us will require more care than we can receive in our home. Maybe an injury or illness has occurred that requires full-time skilled care. The onset of Alzheimer's Disease or other forms of dementia can make it difficult and unsafe to live at home.

Choosing a nursing facility or other type of long-term care facility can be an overwhelming prospect. *Where do I begin? What do I look for? How can I tell if it's the right one for me?*

First, a CARE assessment (Client Assessment and Referral Evaluation) is required to enter a Medicare/Medicaid certified nursing facility to determine the appropriate level of care needed. This can be done in your home by a CARE specialist from the Jayhawk Area Agency on Aging. The Level I CARE assessment will provide a “level of care score” to the KanCare Clearinghouse for those wishing to utilize Medicaid as payment for nursing facility care. The Level I screens for “functional eligibility” only; the KanCare clearinghouse determines fiscal eligibility for Medicaid. If you are in a hospital, the social worker or discharge planner can complete the assessment. Once your level of care has been determined, you can begin the search for facilities in your desired area.

Choosing a nursing home or other long-term care facility is an important decision that often begins when an individual's needs require more support than can be provided at home. Experts recommend first identifying the person's care needs, preferences, and priorities — such as medical services, social activities, location near family, or specialized memory care. Talking with health professionals, friends, community groups, or others who have experience with local facilities can also help narrow options.

Visiting several facilities is ideal whenever possible. During visits, pay attention to cleanliness, staff interactions with residents, activity options, safety features, licensing and certification status, and overall atmosphere. Asking detailed questions about staffing, medical care, activities, costs, and contracts can help ensure expectations are clear before making a decision.

If you can't tour the facilities, request virtual tours or photos/videos from staff, review publicly available inspection reports and complaint histories, and ask detailed questions by phone about staffing levels, services, person-centered care, and daily routines.

How to Choose a Nursing Facility

Each facility is different, so get detailed information about costs and which services are included. Find out if Medicare, Medicaid, or long-term care insurance will pay for any of the costs. The facility may have a financial office that can help you determine what assistance is available. The average cost for a semi-private nursing home room in Kansas is over \$6,000 a month.

Once you select a facility, read the contract carefully. Make sure all the agreements are clear and ask questions about anything you don't understand. Read over the contract again before signing it.

Medicaid (KanCare)

Pays for nursing facility costs for those with limited income and assets, after personal resources have been exhausted.

Medicare

Pays under limited circumstances, short-term following a qualified hospital stay.

Medicare Supplemental Insurance

Usually dependent on if Medicare will pay.

Long-Term Care Insurance

Private insurance that pays for a variety of services. Coverage varies per policy.

Personal Resources

Savings or investments.

PEAK Program

A pay-for-performance Medicaid program to increase the adoption rate of person-centered care practices in Kansas nursing homes.

Below are the PEAK Levels. Please see "*Nursing Facilities*" under Community Resources and Services to see which facilities in your area are part of the PEAK Program.

Mentor Homes (Level 8)

The highest level homes that excel in person-directed practices and help guide other homes

Sustained Person-Centered Care Home (Level 7)

Long-term leaders and homes that maintain excellent person-directed practices

Person-Centered Care Home (Level 6)

Full person-centered directed homes that meet all current standards

Level 5 Homes

Homes close to reaching full person-directed practices

Level 4 Homes

Homes implementing and sustaining several person-directed practices

Level 3 Homes

Homes improving in multiple person-directed areas

Level 2 Homes

Homes actively working on person-directed changes in a few, targeted areas

Level 1 Homes

Homes beginning to make person-directed changes

In-Home Services

Kansas Aging and Disability Resource Center

The Kansas Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) is a comprehensive service resource catering to individuals of all ages, abilities, and income levels, along with their caregivers, to address long-term service and support needs.

The ADRC, operated by Liberty Healthcare Corporation (Liberty), provides objective information and personalized options counseling to help older adults and people with disabilities make informed choices about their services and supports. Liberty provides coverage across Kansas and offers a wide range of long-term support options, connecting people to services that match their preferences, strengths, and values. Additionally, ADRC provides a statewide call center (855-200-2372) staffed with knowledgeable personnel, delivering information, referrals, and assistance for community services.

A variety of in-home services are available, each with different payment and funding sources and eligibility criteria. Here are a few examples to help you understand your options:

AAA Services

The **Senior Care Act** program was established by the Kansas Legislature to assist Kansas residents age 60 or older who have functional limitations in self-care and independent living, but who are able to reside in a community-based residence if some services are provided.

The program provides in-home services to persons who contribute to the cost of services based on their ability to pay. Services vary by county but may include attendant care, respite care, homemaker support, chore services, and adult day care. KDADS administers the program through the AAAs.

The **Older Americans Act** (OAA) was enacted by Congress in 1965 to address the lack of community social services for older adults. It established grants for community planning, social services, research, and training in aging. OAA provides legal assistance, caregiver support, in-home services, transportation, and nutrition programs to older adults. Services are offered on a free or contribution basis. KDADS administers the program through the AAAs.

In-Home Services

Older Americans Act, Continued

Legal Assistance

Legal assistance and elder rights programs work in conjunction with other Administration on Aging (AoA) programs and services to maximize the independence, autonomy and well-being of older persons.

Title III-B attorneys provide legal assistance nationwide on issues such as income security, health care, long-term care, nutrition, housing, utilities, protective services, defense of guardianship, abuse, neglect, and age discrimination. Legal assistance is targeted towards older individuals in social and economic need.

Legal assistance is available in older Kansans through contracts between the Area Agencies on Aging and Kansas Legal Services. Kansas Legal Services may be contacted thru the Kansas Elder Law Hotline at 888-353-5337 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday.

Caregiver Support

Annually, each AAA will receive an allocation of limited federal funds for Family Caregiver Support Program (FCSP) services. The services that may be available include: information, assistance, caregiver training, individual counseling, support groups, supplemental services, and respite care. Respite enables a caregiver to be temporarily relieved from their caregiving responsibilities.

Supportive Services

Home and Community-Based Supportive Services grants fund a broad array of services that enable seniors to remain in their homes for as long as possible. These services include but are not limited to:

- Access services such as transportation, case management, and information and assistance;
- In-home services such as personal care, chore, and homemaker assistance; and
- Community services such as legal services, mental health services, and adult day care.

This program also funds multi-purpose senior centers that coordinate and integrate services for the older adults such as congregate meals, community education, health screening, exercise/health promotion programs and transportation.

Nutrition Programs

The OAA nutrition program is designed to:

- Reduce hunger and food insecurity,
- Promote socialization, and
- Support health and well-being among older adults.

Under Title III-C, services include congregate meals (group dining settings), home-delivered meals (for homebound individuals), and approved alternatives such as grab-and-go or carryout meals when permitted.

Eligibility generally includes individuals age 60 or older (and in some cases their spouses or eligible individuals with disabilities living with them), with priority given to those with the greatest economic or social need.

In-Home Services

Home Health Services following an injury or hospital stay

If you are under a physician's care and are prescribed home health care services, Medicare or Medicaid may cover in-home services for short-term needs, as long as a care plan is established. You must use a home health agency certified to provide Medicare and Medicaid services. Private insurance, Medicare supplement, or long-term care insurance may also cover some home health care expenses. Many home health agencies offer private pay options.

Medicaid (KanCare) Services

To participate in HCBS programs, you must be approved for Medicaid (KanCare) and meet the functional eligibility criteria. The initial functional assessment is completed by Maximus.

The HCBS programs are coordinated by the current Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) under KanCare. Care Managers set up a plan of care to determine the number of hours and types of service needed.

HCBS Frail Elderly (FE) Waiver

For adults age 65+. Must meet criteria for nursing home placement, be Medicaid eligible, and need help with activities of daily living. Services may include: Adult day care, personal care services, personal emergency response, home telehealth, medication reminders, enhanced care services, and more.

Medicaid (KanCare)

KanCare is the program through which the State of Kansas administers Medicaid.

Kansas has contracted with three health plans, or MCOs, to coordinate health care for all people enrolled in Medicaid.

KanCare health plans are required to coordinate all of the different types of care a consumer receives. The goals of the KanCare program are to improve overall health outcomes while slowing the rate of cost growth over time.

KanCare can be used in conjunction with Medicare benefits and covers some services not covered by Medicare, including nursing home and long-term care services. Participants may also receive financial assistance for Medicare Part D (prescription drug) expenses.

Who is eligible?

KanCare provides health coverage for: Qualifying children under age 19, pregnant women, adults, non-disabled, non-elderly parents or caregivers of children younger than 19, individuals age 65 and over, and individuals with disabilities.

Medicaid (KanCare)

KanCare Ombudsman

The KanCare Ombudsman provides an independent and confidential resource for Kansas Medicaid recipients. The KanCare Ombudsman office can assist with answering questions, resolving issues, completing applications or renewals, and learning about in-home services.

Navigating Medicare

Medicare is a federal health insurance program in the United States that provides coverage primarily for people age 65 and older, as well as certain younger individuals with disabilities and people with end-stage renal disease.

Medicare.gov is the official U.S. government website for Medicare and is managed by the U.S. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Senior Health Insurance Counseling for Kansas (SHICK)

SHICK is a free program offering Kansans an opportunity to talk with trained, community volunteers and get answers to questions about Medicare and other insurance issues. SHICK counselors are located throughout the state and can help individuals stay informed on changing conditions in health care insurance. Counselors receive training on Medicare, Medicare Supplemental Insurance, Long-Term Care Insurance, and other health insurance subjects that concern older Kansans. They do not work for any insurance company. The goal is to educate and assist the public in making informed decisions. Need Help Paying Premiums?

Medicare Savings Program

The Medicare Savings Program is a federal initiative designed to aid Medicare beneficiaries in managing the costs associated with Part A, Part B, and Part D premiums, as well as deductibles and co-pays, based on their income level. Eligibility for this program is contingent upon meeting monthly income criteria and adhering to maximum asset thresholds. Navigating Medicare

Extra Help

Medicare Part D provides prescription drug coverage. The Extra Help program helps with the cost of prescription drugs, deductibles and copays. You can apply for Extra Help any time before or after you enroll in Part D. Apply online at www.ssa.gov/medicare/part-d-extra-help or contact your local Social Security Office.



Red Flags for Elder Abuse and Neglect

Every year an estimated 5 million, or 1 in 10 older Americans experience elder abuse, neglect, or exploitation.

Elder abuse refers to any form of mistreatment or harm inflicted upon an older person, typically aged 60 or above. Abuse can occur within various relationships including family, caregiver, or institutional settings. Types of abuse can include physical abuse, sexual abuse, emotional and psychological abuse, verbal abuse, neglect, passive neglect, willful deprivation, and financial exploitation.

Signs of physical abuse include hitting, pinching, shoving, force-feeding, and rough handling, along with physical indicators such as bruises, skin tears, absence of hair, cuts, rope marks, over-medication, chemical restraint, and reports from the individual of being abused. Signs of neglect can include weight loss due to lack of assistance with eating and drinking, delayed response to restroom requests leading to loss of bladder or bowel control, unpleasant body odors from lack of hygiene, pressure sores, dehydration, lack of mental, medical, or dental care, reduced mobility due to lack of walking assistance, ignoring cries for help, and failure to administer prescribed medication.

How to Report Elder Abuse

If you or someone you know is in a life threatening situation or in immediate danger, contact 911 or local law enforcement.

Report as soon as you have a concern!

To report suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation in the community or in facilities licensed by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services when the perpetrator is not a resident of or staff of the facility, contact Adult Protective Services at 800-922-5330.

How to Report Elder Abuse Continued

To report suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation in an adult care home (nursing facility, assisted living facility, home plus, adult day care...), in a medical care facility, or occurring with a home health agency, contact Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services at 800-842-0078.

To report suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation in states other than Kansas, contact the Kansas Aging and Disability Resource Center for information at 855-200-2372.

Social Security Information

Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) are federal programs administered by the Social Security Administration (SSA) to provide financial assistance to individuals with disabilities and unable to work.

Social Security Disability Insurance

SSDI provides benefits to individuals who have a disability that prevents them from engaging in substantial gainful activity and have worked and paid Social Security taxes for a certain period. Eligibility for SSDI is based on work history and work credits earned through payment of Social Security taxes. The number of credits needed depends on the age at which the individual became disabled.

Supplemental Security Income

SSI provides monthly payments to people with disabilities, people who are blind, and older adults who have little or no income or resources. Workers who have paid Social Security taxes for 10 years or more and are age 62 are eligible for early social security benefits. SSDI will convert to Social Security retirement benefits at “full retirement age”.

What are my Long-Term Care Housing Options?

Independent Living

A variety of housing options, including apartments, duplexes, and condominiums are accessible, offering both private pay and subsidized arrangements (such as through HUD or other income-based rent programs). The amenities, services, and activities offered differ among these options, and certain choices may require an application process and waitlist. Independent living communities are not regulated or licensed by the state.

Continuing Care Retirement Communities (CCRCs)

CCRCs, or life care communities, offer a continuum of care so residents can move from independent living to higher levels of care without leaving the community. However, they can be expensive and typically require a significant upfront “buy-in” cost.

Home Plus

Home Plus are residences or facilities caring for no more than 12 individuals who, due to functional impairment, need personal care and may need supervised nursing care to compensate for activities of daily living limitations. Home Plus are not regulated by the federal government but are licensed by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services.

Assisted Living/

Residential Health Care Facilities

Assisted living facilities and residential health care facilities (RHCF) offer a residential care setting for older adults who want their own living space. Residents may need help with dressing, bathing, eating, and toileting, but do not require the intensive medical and nursing care provided in a nursing home. RHCFs are very similar to assisted living facilities but do not offer kitchenettes in an individual’s room. Assisted living facilities and RHCFs are not regulated by the federal government but are licensed by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services.

Nursing Facility

Nursing facilities provide 24-hour care for individuals who can no longer live independently. A nursing facility setting also may be appropriate for people who need extended post-operative care, complex medical monitoring, nursing, medical, social and rehabilitative care. All nursing facilities are licensed and regulated by state governments, while those licensed by Medicaid/Medicare are additionally regulated by the federal government.
