Supervisor Legault explained the capital account has been depleted due to water purchases from the Village of Massena. Total paid to date: \$187,935.44. Some reimbursement is expected from EFC funds when the project ends; not all will be reimbursed. The project is expected to finish by the end of March and includes changing out pumps. Proposal to move funds from water reserves to the capital account to cover costs. The Town Board agreed to take two-thirds from the District One reserve and one-third from the District Three reserve.

Water Clerk informed the Town Board that John experienced technical issues connecting the Neptune Mobile Data Collector (MRXV2) to the tablet, which prevented him from completing the meter reads. He reached out to TI Sales Technical Support and they ran through several troubleshooting protocols without success. Shawn McArdle, AMI Systems Manager at TI Sales. Stated that there is no real fix for these older Mobile Data Collectors; the Town's current MRXV2 model was purchased in June 2013. He offered that we could mail the unit to TI Sales in Sudbury, MA and that their Technical Support team could try to restore the connection, but success isn't guaranteed. The only other option is to replace the current Mobile Data Collector with the newest model, MRX920V4E.
