Concessionary Bus Pass

Are you eligible for a free concessionary bus pass?

You are eligible for a free concessionary bus pass through the English National Concessionary Travel Scheme, if you have reached state pension age.

For a disability bus pass, there are 7 recognised disabilities for the scheme which must be permanent, have lasted 12 months or be likely to last at least 12 months.

The best way to find out if you are eligible is to check with your local authority.

FREE travel on off-peak scheduled bus services in England.

FREE local journeys before 9:30 am for journeys originating in Lincolnshire



WHERE YOU CAN USE YOUR CONCESSIONARY BUS PASS – LINCS COUNTY COUNCIL

These passes allow you free travel on off-peak scheduled bus services in England. They also allow you free local journeys before 9.30am for journeys originating in Lincolnshire.


You can use your bus pass on all local bus services in England but not on the following types of non-standard service:

- services where most seats can be reserved (for example, National Express or other long distance services)
- rail replacement services
- park and ride services
- coach excursions and tours
- taxis and private hire cars
- trains
- certain seasonal services
- community transport schemes

Your pass will not be valid in other countries including Scotland and Wales.



Park & Ride in Lincoln

If you're travelling to Lincoln by car, the Park & Ride will save you the hassle of driving into the city centre. Using this handy bus service will allow you to arrive stress free, have a positive impact on the environment and save money on parking.

Running from Monday – Saturday, the Park & Ride in Lincoln starts from Waitrose on Searby Road. Buses run every 15 minutes, and stop at the following locations:

- Nettleham Road: The inbound stop is adjacent to KFC, opposite the Waitrose car park
- Northgate: Next to Lincoln Cathedral
- Broadgate: Inbound only for the city centre
- Lincoln Bus Station: For the High Street and St Marks Shopping Centre

The first bus departs Waitrose at 6.48am during the week, and 7.48am on Saturdays. The last return bus will leave Lincoln Bus Station at 6.20pm.



Home / Services / Walk & Ride

Walk & Ride for getting up Steep Hill

Walk and Ride (sometimes called the 'Steep Hill Shuttle' or the 'Castle Shuttle') gets you straight to the Cathedral quarter without having to negotiate Steep Hill. The Walk and Ride is operated by PC Coaches and runs throughout the day Monday to Saturday except on public holidays.

Children under 5 and concessionary bus pass holders ride for free. You must be aged 15 or younger to be eligible for the child tickets.


Timetable and Route

Walk and Ride begins at Stonebow on the High Street outside of The Works, a stationary and book store, and drops off at multiple tourist hpot spots including: The Cathedral, Newport Arch, The Lawn, and finally completing its journey directly opposite the Tourist Information Centre at The Castle.

InterConnect 1 - Lincoln to Grantham

InterConnect 1 runs 7 days a week from Lincoln to Grantham, serving Waddington, Harmston, Coleby, Boothby Graffoe, Navenby, Wellingore, Welbourn, Leadenham, Fulbeck, Caythorpe, Normanton, Honington, Barkston and Manthorpe along the way.

The service runs **up to every 30 minutes**, with the first journey Monday to Friday starting 0515 from Lincoln and 0628 from Grantham. The last journey from Lincoln is at 1815 and from Grantham at 1945.



InterConnect 56 - Lincoln to Skegness

InterConnect 56 runs 7 days a week from Lincoln to Skegness via Sudbrooke, Langworth, Wragby, Hatton, Baumber, Horncastle, High Toynton, Hagworthingham, Raithby, Spilsby, Partney, Candlesby and Burgh Le Marsh.

The service runs **up to every 60 minutes**, with the first journey from Lincoln being at 0600 and 0530 from Skegness Monday to Friday and 0800 from on Saturdays. InterConnect 56 also runs hourly on Sundays.



InterConnect 53 - Lincoln to Grimsby

InterConnect 53 runs from Lincoln to Grimsby. The service connects
Nettleham, Welton, Dunholme, Faldingworth, Linwood, Middle Rasen with
Market Rasen. Then from Market Rasen to Holton Le Moor, Nettleton,
Caistor, Cabourne and Laceby before arriving in Grimsby.

The service runs up to **every 60 minutes**, starting from Lincoln at 0640 Monday to Saturday and from Grimsby at 0635 Monday to Saturday.
