Programs are available to lowincome children and teens at no cost. Students learn life skills and behaviors to succeed in school, family, and the workplace. We provide Mentoring and Life-skills training. EVERY Youth Center program includes a meal for every student! Each day at Camp Summit, kids and teens receive three delicious and nutritious meals. Our Food Pantry is available for any- one needing food assistance. YouthHope provides transportation to and from programs. We pick up kids and teens from school or home to ensure transportation is not a barrier to attend. YouthHope partners with 18 Public Schools and serves 36 lowincome neighborhoods.

To bring at-risk children and teens from low-income areas into a life-changing relationship with Christ by encouraging, empowering, and equipping them through Community Outreach, Youth Center, and Camp Summit Programs.

OUR PURPOSE

We passionately and persistently pursue at-risk kids and teens through authentic relationships to lead them to HOPE in Jesus! We utilize holistic curriculum and programs to meet the Spiritual, physical, emotional, educational, and vocational needs of low-income and at-risk youth.

- **Spiritual:** Jesus is the answer to every need. We present the Gospel always.
- **Physical:** Programs integrate physical activity and games.
- Emotional: Teaching spiritual basis for emotional processing.
- **Educational:** Provide mentoring, tutoring and homework help.
- Vocational: Life skills, scholarships, and exposure to opportunities.

OUR HISTORY

YouthHope has been serving the Quad Cities community for the past 89 years! A strong, volunteer-led beginning started in 1936 by a women's Bible Study Group in Rock Island, Ilinois. With the original name of Christian Friendliness Association, our beginning was in response to the needs of immigrants and families in low-income areas. YouthHope has a legacy of impact and continues to faithfully serve at-risk youth and families in need.



Community Outreach

Our Fall Party was our largest Evangelism Event yet in YouthHope's history! Families from the community came for the bounce houses, fun games, entertainment, prizes and a free meal. During this outreach event, 220 kids (plus parents) heard the Gospel message shared, and more than 100 kids raised their hand to accept Christ!

Two Elementary Schools during in-school hours for students selected by school counselors as high-risk and need emotional encouragement, behavior support, and positive influence.

QUAD CITY YOUTH CONFERENCE

Engaged 500+ junior high/high school students with information, support, and ministry moments.

Youth Centers

An 8th-grade boy attended our Teen Guy's Night Program after being kicked out of his home. His mother, troubled by the choices he was making, gave him an ultimatum: Go to YouthHope to show he was ready to change. Staff sat down with him, and shared how his choices will lead him to Heaven or Hell. In that moment, He chose Heaven! Our team led him in a prayer to receive Jesus. He is now a regular in our Youth Center programs!

Stories like this highlight why we do what we do—bringing hope, transformation, and the love of Christ to those who need it most.

901 unique students attended

Every challenge we encounter is an opportunity to love kids well and minister to their needs in meaningful ways. YouthHope offers after-school, evening and weekend programs for kids and teens grades K-12. Youth have a safe, structured and supervised place to learn, play and grow all year! CRE8 Studios, a creative arts ministry, incorporates life skills and arts enrichment through sewing, dance, music, theatre, spoken word, ceramics, and art. Kids and teens play and decompress after school, enjoy free gym time, work on homework, and have fun! Every student receives a meal at EVERY program!

Transportation is provided to and from the youth center programs. Bible Lessons, Scripture Memorization, Worship, and Prayer are always the center of programs. Kids read God's Word, learn about His love, and find HOPE in Christ.

- 8 week-long sessions of sleep-away camp
- Bible lessons about who God Is (Exodus 34:6)
- Live Worship and Guest Speakers
- A break from screens and poverty-related stress
- New friends, s'mores and more!

Teams work together and learn communication, forgiveness, and teamwork. Camp Staff are positive role models who exhibit patience, conflict resolution, and respect. Campers have group devotions, worship, and a place to ask all their questions about God!


