Transformed Lives at Camp Summit

YouthHope staff talk with campers while driving them back home and ask what was your favorite part of Camp Summit? Here are some responses:

"My counselor" "Making a new friend"

That last one required more context! The staff asked, "What made you cry?" Without hesitation, the boy responded, "It was the Lord!"



At Camp Summit, kids and teens experience the presence of Christ that brings healing and wholeness. Campers encounter Christ's presence and return home forever changed.

A Wednesday-night worship service and message quickly became a night of healing and freedom for many Junior High Girls!

Wednesday night message at camp began like any other worship service, but everything changed as the Holy Spirit began to move. That evening became a powerful celebration of freedom and new beginnings for many young women.

During worship, a well-loved and appreciated camp counselor felt led to open up to the girls and share her testimony—past struggles and how God had set her free. As the junior high girls listened intently, they realized they were not alone in their struggles. A group of young girls approached the counselor hesitantly and ultimately revealed that they were struggling just as she once had.



In that moment, the counselor shared that if God could break her chains, He could do the same for them. He does not want to leave them in their sin and shame but to bring redemption and hope! This breakthrough—ordained by the Spirit of God—indicated that the Holy Spirit was moving, at work, and had a plan for the girls. This group of girls, once strangers, continued sharing their stories and struggles, building bonds and growing deeper in connection—they were not alone. After sharing, they were met with love, understanding, encouragement, and, most importantly, prayer.

Many heard for the first time the truth of God's healing power and the freedom He offers. God's Spirit is moving, breaking chains, healing, and calling His children into a relationship with Him and inviting them to walk boldly in freedom, free of shame!
