In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 775, notice is hereby given of a Public Hearing conducted by the Board of Commissioners of the Ellis County Emergency Services District No. 6, to be held at the **ESD #6 VFD BUILDING LOCATED AT 1816 FM 66, ONE MILE WEST OF I-35E**, Waxahachie, Texas, at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, **August 6, 2026**.

- D. Acknowledge and approve posting of "Notice About 2026 Tax Rates" and "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" to home page of the District's website.

V. Approve the Station 2 contract change orders for Grossman Design Build, either their not-to-exceed quote or their final bid.
