

#### Message from the Exhibition Chair

Springfield Museum of Art is home to the only Smithsonian Affiliate art museum in the state of Ohio, a distinction that celebrates adherence to best practices and an exemplary permanent collection. At the same time, they host a variety of other exhibitions including—this year—ours! While the OWS has had two annual exhibitions in Springfield—the last in 1992—this year's show is being held in a recently renovated museum that can accommodate the exhibition itself, the workshop given by our juror Paul Jackson and the opening reception and awards banquet. Having a single site for all events is not a common situation for us!

Besides the physical spaces, the staff of the SoMA has been equally accommodating and helpful. Executive Director Jessimi Jones and Curator Jennifer Wenker paved the way to set up the exhibition and worked with us to craft a plan to optimize its success. Development Officer Patrick Wicker was instrumental in mapping the logistics and providing on-site, up-to-the-minute help in many ways from helping to arrange the banquet to figuring how to display Paul Jackson's demonstration and workshop instruction.

Our own volunteers were both efficient and pleasing to work with during take-in and the re-boxing of the work for storage between take-in and hanging. This despite power failures and stormy weather in the area during that weekend. Their names are listed in the catalog, which is a small token of our appreciation for their hard work and time.

Cathy Welner is this year's winner of the Jim Brower Lifetime Achievement Award. She is well known to many members of OWS—as well as many others—for her many years of teaching watercolor painting in northeast Ohio as well as being an exceptional artist in her own right. Cathy embodies the best qualities we commend in our members and we are proud for her to receive this honor.

Our Juror, Paul Jackson, was a pleasure to work with and remained chipper and helpful as we worked to tweak several things at the last minute in response to weather events sweeping through southern Ohio in late July. His demo and workshop were very well-received. Given how many events he was juggling this year around the country, we were fortunate to have him.

#### Juror's Biography

#### Paul Jackson AWS~DF, NWS

Paul Jackson spent his adventurous childhood in Starkville Mississippi. He discovered his passion for watercolor at Mississippi State University in 1985. He received a Master of Fine Arts degree in Missouri in 1992, and has since been relentless in pursuit of his creative dreams, receiving top honors in national and international competitions, contributing his art to a vast library of magazines and books and sharing his creative influence in all corners of the earth.

Paul was honored by the American Watercolor Society with signature membership at the age of 30, and more recently with the Dolphin Fellowship, the highest honor in watercolor painting. Paul is also a Signature member of the National Watercolor Society and an Honor Member of the Missouri Watercolor Society.

Paul was the Grand Prize winner in the Paint Your Way to Paris competition and has been featured as one of the Master Painters of the World in International Artists Magazine. Much of Paul's portfolio of watercolors hangs in private collections, but some examples

are on display in museums and public buildings: the Missouri State Capitol, Governor's Mansion and Supreme Court all prominently feature Jackson watercolors.

In 2008, Jackson was the featured speaker at the International Watercolor Masters Invitational in Lushan, China. Paul was also the only American artist invited to the International Art Meet in Kolkata, India in 2011. Jackson frequently serves as judge for national and international art competitions.

A prolific artist and ambitious world traveler, Paul Jackson is one of today's most versatile and visible contemporary watercolorists. Whether his subject is landscape, cityscape, portrait, architecture, still life or abstract, Paul captivates his audience with genuine emotion, intensity and finesse that energize each of his creations.

#### Juror's Statement



It was a privilege to serve as juror for the 2025 Ohio Watercolor Society Exhibition – an experience that offered not only a front-row seat to exceptional artistry, but a renewed appreciation for the many ways this luminous medium continues to evolve.

Watercolor is a medium of endless possibility. It can whisper or shout, dazzle with precision or drift like memory across the page. What struck me most in reviewing this year's submissions was the breadth of voices and approaches represented...each with something distinctly personal to say. From traditional realism to experimental abstraction, from intimate studies to bold, expansive statements, the works in this exhibition are united by their mastery and conviction. I was especially intrigued by the diversity of surfaces explored—most notably, two of the top five award-winning pieces were painted on Yupo. That alone is rare. But even more rare is seeing the surface used so effectively, with the kind of control and intentionality that elevates difficulty into something seamless. When handled well, Yupo brings a unique vibrancy to watercolor, and those artists earned every accolade.

Judging a show of this caliber is never easy. I spent time returning to each piece, looking closely for design strength, technical skill, clarity of concept, and emotional resonance. I'm drawn to work that surprises me, that invites a second look and then a third. I hope every artist knows how much their work was valued in this process.

To the Ohio Watercolor Society, thank you for your commitment to celebrating and uplifting watercolor in all its forms. To the exhibiting artists, thank you for your courage, your craft, and your stories. You've made this exhibition a dynamic and inspiring snapshot of where watercolor is headed. And to everyone who took the time to enter, please keep painting! The world is better with your vision in it.

#### Ohio Watercolor Society Jim Brower Lifetime Achievement Award

#### **Cathy Welner**



Cathy Welner was born in Syracuse New York to James and Viola Panto of Sicilian and Italian descent. An only child, Cathy grew up in a multilingual extended family home with her parents, grandparents, an aunt, an uncle, a cousin and a dog that understood the language. Cathy's mother, a beautiful and extraordinary woman who loved to paint and draw, was a great inspiration to her daughter. No surprise then that art and music always filled the house, and Cathy was encouraged to take singing, dancing and Saturday morning

art classes as a child.

Upon graduating high school Cathy attended the State University Of New York at Cortland, (SUNY) from which she

graduated with a BS degree in Education. She also met her future husband there. After marriage and a brief stint of teaching, they started their family and eventually had three children, David, Sharon and Lauri. As they grew, Cathy decided after a time to pursue her interest in art and began taking classes with Lowell Ellsworth Smith of Hudson, Ohio as well as other local, national and international artists available at the time. As her own style began to emerge, she was encouraged to start teaching. And so the journey began!

Joining the fledgling Ohio Watercolor Society shortly after its inception, Cathy was elected to signature membership in 1980 and subsequently served as Treasurer in the early 1980s. She has been a frequent exhibitor in the annual juried exhibition (Watercolor Ohio) and elected to the selection committee in 1983. During her years participating in Watercolor Ohio, Cathy has had two paintings selected for purchase for the OWS Permanent Collection; and among other awards she was given the Gold Buckeye Leaf Award in 2020 for her painting, Winter Woods.

Besides membership in the OWS, Cathy's associations with art and in particular with watercolor painting has led to exhibitions locally, nationally and

internationally since the 1970's, and she has won many awards and honors. She was elected to lifetime membership in the Whisky Painters of America and in 2024, to signature membership in the American Watercolor Society. Cathy was a freelance artist for the American Greetings Corporation, based in Westlake, Ohio; and she is a member of the Hudson Society of Artists (Hudson, Ohio) where she founded (and chaired for 43 years!) Hudson Art on the Green, a juried fine arts and crafts show that features works of over 140 exhibitors.

While Cathy's artistic talent is undisputed, the most enduring legacy is probably her devotion to teaching. Cathy has taught workshops around the country and for several summers on Lake Como, Italy. Closer to home, Cathy was on the faculty of The Department of Continuing Education at the Cleveland Institute of Art and for many years has taught workshops and classes at The Cliffside Artists Collaborative (Hinckley, Ohio), which is committed to art education and to the encouragement of young artists planning a career in art.

Cathy says, "I would never have met some of the people or gone to some of the places I've been if it wasn't for this wonderful world of art. What a blessing!"

Her own words are just as true for her contributions to the Ohio Watercolor Society as well as many artists and residents of Ohio: What a blessing!
