Why do we need a grotto?

The Grotto will provide a peaceful outdoor space for prayer, reflection, and experiencing God's presence in the beauty of nature.

How much will the Grotto cost?

A committee is currently researching and developing cost estimates. More information will be shared as planning progresses.

Who will pay for the Grotto and statues?

The project will be funded entirely through voluntary donations from parishioners, families, and parish ministries.

Who will maintain the Grotto?

Volunteers from existing parish ministries, including the Garden Angels and Knights of Columbus, will care for and maintain the site.

What are the long-term expenses?

Ongoing costs are expected to be minimal. Volunteers will handle maintenance, with only modest expenses for lighting.

Will the Grotto be open to the public?

Yes. The Grotto is intended to be open to everyone, including parishioners, visitors, other churches, and members of the community.

Would donations be better used for other parish ministries?

The Grotto will be funded through designated donations and will not reduce support for existing ministries. Instead, it will enhance parish life by providing a dedicated place for prayer and reflection.
