

A Note From Our Pastor



Question: Is it right to sue someone? Isn't it a way of getting revenge?



Answer: Revenge is inflicting harm for harm's sake, the idea of an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, and then some. There is often a fine line between justice and mercy, between compensation and forgiveness. Unfortunately, things can happen to us that cause harm, suffering, and damage, regardless of people's intentions. When someone is hurt, especially in such a way that special care or treatment is required, the cost of that care needs to be paid.

In a perfect world, those with special needs, handicaps, or disabilities would find the help and care they need, including those who are injured or hurt. But justice is not always forthcoming, and people are not always fair. So, using the legal system to right a wrong is sometimes the only option.

In some cases, it is the only way that people can get the help they need and deserve. However, frivolous lawsuits, or 'fishing for money' is not only unfair, but immoral as well. The law is there to protect people and making use of it when necessary is a good thing.©LPi

Dear St. Mary Parishioners:

The National Eucharistic Revival is a three-year initiative by the U.S. bishops that aims to inspire, educate, and unite the faithful in a more intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist. In light of this, St. Mary Parish in Mokena will reintroduce kneelers at all Masses for the reception of Holy Communion. On Saturday, October 21st, at the 5:00pm Vigil Mass two kneelers will be placed in the center aisle. Receipt of the Eucharist will be uncomplicated. Those receiving communion may choose to stand in front of the kneeler and receive in the hand or on the tongue as usual. Alternatively, one may choose to kneel and receive on the hand or the tongue. This method will be available at all Masses: daily Mass, Saturday Vigil Mass at 5:00pm, and all Sunday Masses.

St. Mary started its participation in the Eucharist Revival with its initiation of a perpetual Eucharistic Adoration chapel and a Eucharistic procession in 2022.

In our society discussion of God and efforts to spur reverence and respect have fallen by the wayside. Sadly, a majority of Catholics do not believe in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It is our hope and intent to turn that percentage around. St. Mary will devote its efforts to reestablish love and admiration of the Eucharist.

Those who have been "healed, converted, formed, and unified" by the Eucharist have a calling to impart to our friends and family the love and respect Our Lord deserves and expects from His followers.

St. Mary invites all to return to the source and summit of our faith, the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.
