

A Note From Our Pastor



Why are some saints honored as "patron saints"?



Answer: Each person is unique and each of us has different gifts, interests, talents, and, yes, even struggles and areas where we need to grow. This is no less true of those holy women, men, and children who have been canonized or beatified.

Because we believe that the saints and blesseds are both models of faith and intercessors, Christians have looked to certain holy people as role models and heavenly protectors for occupations, spiritual charisms, and even places. Although the Church sometimes names a person as a patron saint (e.g. Saint Philip Neri as the patron of Rome, Saint Clare of Assisi as the patroness of television, or Saint Aloysius Gonzaga as the patron of youth and young adults), more often it is popular devotion that inspires lay Christians to turn to a particular saint or blessed for heavenly help and support. This is how, for example, Saint Cecilia came to be honored as the patroness of musicians, Saint Toribio Romo as patron of migrants coming into the United States, and Saint Gertrude of Nivelles as patroness of cat lovers. Although there are official and unofficial lists of patron saints, we should always feel free to ask any and all the saints to give us their patronage and protection in whatever it is that we need.©LPi





Do you pay income taxes to the State of Illinois?

Regardless of the Illinois Legislature's decision, you still have the opportunity to change a student's future, while lowering your tax liability. Make your donation before December 31, 2023 to have it count towards your 2023 taxes.

Unfortunately, the Illinois Legislature recently failed to extend the Invest In Kids Scholarship Program and currently it expires on December 31, 2023. You can still make a difference before the end of the school year and help SMS students!

While this program expires on 12/31, the sooner you're able to donate, the more we will be able to help SMS students directly.

First of all, every dollar matters. Second, if you or your business pays income taxes to the State of Illinois, you have the ability to quadruple your gift while reducing and possibly eliminating your state income tax liability.

The Invest in Kids Act, passed in 2017, allows individuals and businesses to receive a 75% state tax credit for scholarship donations. The donations are made to a scholarship granting organization, like Empower Illinois and can be designated for middle- and lowincome families who wish to attend SMS.

This program has been transformational for other schools, driving enrollment and investment.

It could do the same for SMS.
Only 8 students receive scholarships through this program, but 9 are on the waitlist.

HOW DO YOU GIVE TO THIS IMPORTANT PROGRAM?

We ask that you follow the steps outlined on Empower Illinois (empowerillinois.org). They have helpful resources, including step-by-step guides and FAQs.

HOW CAN YOU QUADRUPLE YOUR GIFT?

Here's an individual example- we will call him Tom - with a \$3,000 state income tax liability. Typically, Tom makes a \$1,000 donation to SMS; but this year he decided to donate \$4,000 through Empower Illinois. By doing so, Tom gets a \$3,000 state tax credit (\$4,000 × 75%). He is still out of pocket \$1,000 but he has reduced his state income tax liability to \$0 and increased his giving to \$4,000.

WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM?

Individuals and businesses earning taxable income in the State of Illinois.
 Individuals who take the standard deduction on their federal income tax.
 Individuals and businesses who would benefit more from a 75% state tax credit than an additional deduction at the federal level (consult your tax advisor).




