

From Your Pastor

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus.

I just want to share something very important to me. We are very blessed to have perpetual Eucharistic adoration in our parish. Not every parish has this gift, but we do. When you enter the adoration chapel, you'll find Jesus there, truly present. He is always waiting for us: ready to listen, comfort, and guide us. As your pastor, I encourage you to make time to visit our adoration chapel. Even just a few quiet minutes with Jesus can make a big difference. You don't have to say much, all you need to do is be there. Sit with Him. Rest in His presence. Let Him speak to your heart. I try to go there regularly, if not every day. Honestly, it helps me very much. It brings peace to my mind, strength to my heart, and reminds me that I'm never alone. I want you to experience that as well.

Just recently, our Men's Ministry had a wonderful conversation about the importance of Eucharistic adoration. Hearing them talk about their own experiences: the way Jesus has touched their lives in that quiet and sacred space was truly inspiring. It reminded me again how powerful it is to simply spend time with the Lord. If you're going through something difficult or challenging, go to Jesus. If you're confused, tired, or in need of peace, go to Jesus. If you're grateful, go to Him. Our adoration chapel was also recently renovated and it has become an even more beautiful place to pray. The Assumption

IS CELEBRATED ON AUGUST 15TH.

The Assumption is the celebration of the end of the Blessed Virgin Mary's life.

The term "Assumption" comes from the Latin word assumptio meaning "to take up" or "to receive". Christ "took up" and "received" His Blessed Mother into heaven, **body and soul**.

The Assumption is a Solemnity. It is also a Holy Day of Obligation.

HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION ARE DAYS ON WHICH WE ARE OBLIGATED (OR REQUIRED) TO ATTEND MASS. SUNDAYS ARE CONSIDERED HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION, ALONG WITH A FEW SOLEMNITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THESE FEW SOLEMNITIES CENTER AROUND THE MOST IMPORTANT MOMENTS IN OUR FAITH.



The Development Office of the Diocese of Joliet is committed to maintaining transparency and open communication with our parishioners. We wish to provide an important update concerning the status of the Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal (CMAA) InPew Envelopes.

We encountered an unexpected challenge with UPS back in March, which resulted in the loss of 23 packages containing InPew Envelopes, many with checks made out to the CMAA. To date, UPS has been unable to locate these missing packages. 
If you find that your check has not been cashed, we recommend you take the necessary steps to stop payment on that check.


