St. Mary Parish has new Relics!

Relics are the remains or remnants of Saints (such as bones or belongings).

There are various types of relics. **First-class relics** come directly from the saint (such as a piece of hair or bone). **Second-class relics** are items that touched the saint (such as a piece of clothing or belonging). **Third-class relics** are items that touched a first-or second-class relic. St. Mary's relics are first- or second-class relics.

THE BIRTHDAY OF

St. Faustina Kowalska
IS AUGUST 25TH.

Christ appeared to St. Faustina numerous times to reveal His love for His people, and how He desires to share His **Divine Mercy**. St. Faustina wrote down Christ's messages to her in her **Diary**. She also was responsible for having the **Divine Mercy image** painted and shared with the world.

The **Divine Mercy Chaplet** is a popular way to show devotion to Christ's Divine Mercy.



THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET IS PRAYED ON A ROSARY. THERE ARE OPTIONAL PRAYERS AT THE BEGINNING, BUT AN "OUR FATHER", A "HAIL MARY", AND THE "APOSTLES' CREED" MUST BE PRAYED BEFORE THE FIRST DECADE. THEN, ON THE "OUR FATHER" BEADS, SAY "ETERNAL FATHER, I OFFER YOU THE BODY AND BLOOD, SOUL AND DIVINITY OF YOUR DEARLY BELOVED SON, OUR LORD, JESUS CHRIST, IN ATONEMENT FOR OUR SINS AND THOSE OF THE WHOLE WORLD."

ON THE "HAIL MARY" BEADS, SAY "FOR THE SAKE OF HIS SORROWFUL PASSION, HAVE MERCY ON US AND ON THE WHOLE WORLD." REPEAT THIS FOR EACH DECADE. AT THE END OF THE CHAPLET, SAY "HOLY GOD, HOLY MIGHTY ONE, HOLY IMMORTAL ONE, HAVE MERCY ON US AND ON THE WHOLE WORLD," THREE TIMES. THERE ARE MORE OPTIONAL PRAYERS TO CLOSE THE CHAPLET.

Our Lady of Fatima Statue


The St. Mary Knights of Columbus would like to give parishioners an opportunity to have this statue of Our Lady of Fatima in






