

#### **From Your Pastor**

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus!

As you may know, we are blessed to welcome a new parochial vicar to our parish family: Fr. Welbert Llyd Suarez, a Filipino priest from our Religious Order. Let us warmly welcome him and take this opportunity to get to know him as he begins his ministry among us.

Fr. Welbert was born and raised in Carrascal, a town in Surigao del Sur, Mindanao, Philippines. He is the second of four siblings. His religious and priestly journey began at the age of 17 when he entered the Rogationist Seminary in Cebu. He made his First Religious Profession of Vows on May 31, 2009. His formation years included valuable pastoral exposure, notably as Brother Assistant at the Saint Hannibal Formation Center in Cebu (2010–2011) and St. Anthony's Boys Village in Davao (2011–2012). He made his Perpetual Profession of Vows on June 1, 2014, at the Fr. Di Francia Center of Studies in Manila. He was ordained a deacon on August 29, 2015, and ordained to the priesthood on November 26, 2016.

Fr. Welbert's first assignment as a priest was as Assistant Parish Priest at Our Lady of the Pillar Parish in Zaragoza, Bolinao, Pangasinan (2016–2019). In early 2019, he also served briefly at Rogationist College Parañaque in student affairs, before being sent to his missionary assignment in Papua New Guinea. Since November 2019, Fr. Welbert has served at the Sideia Mission Center in Alotau, Milne Bay Province. There, he embraced various ministries, including Assistant Parish Priest, Diocesan Youth Coordinator, Vocation Director, and Chaplain of Saint Anne's Skills Training Institute on Sideia Island. In September 2023, he was entrusted with the responsibilities of Parish Priest and Superior of the Rogationist Missionary Community in Sideia, a mission he accepted with humility and deep trust in the Lord.

In all his assignments, Fr. Welbert has carried with him a spirit of service, availability, and generosity. He offers himself entirely to the mission of the Church and the care of God's people. By God's grace, he continues to love and serve wherever he is sent, grateful always for the privilege of his calling. Once again, let us welcome him and keep him in our prayers as he begins this new chapter with us.





Prayer Shawls for the ill, homebound and grieving are like receiving a "Hug from God".




