

From Your Pastor

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus!

At every Mass, there's a quiet but really meaningful moment we sometimes overlook: the Offertory. That's when someone from the congregation offers the bread and wine to the altar. On the surface, it may look like a small task, but there's actually a lot of beauty and meaning behind it. That simple act of carrying the bread and wine is more than just handing something to the priest. It's a sign for all of us that our work, joys and worries, are being offered to God. It's a way for us to say: Here we are, Lord. We give ourselves to You. Pope Benedict XVI once said something beautiful about this: The presentation of the gifts at the altar expresses the spiritual desire of the faithful to offer themselves to God. Even though just a few people present the gifts, they are truly doing it on behalf of the whole parish community. It's not just about walking something forward, it's a small gesture that represents something much bigger.

Every now and then, the ushers might ask if you would be willing to bring up the gifts. If that happens, try not to say no. Don't worry if you feel unsure or shy in front of a crowd. This isn't about being perfect or knowing exactly what to do. It's about saying yes to something meaningful. It's about being willing to take a small step and offer yourself to God in that moment. You don't need to be part of a ministry or have any special role. Whether you are here every Sunday or just visiting, it's a way for anyone to participate.


So, if you are ever asked one day to offer gifts to the altar, do not hesitate to say yes because you are doing something sacred. And if no one asks, feel free to volunteer. If you feel called to bring up the gifts, don't hesitate to let the ushers know before Mass. It's a wonderful way to take part more personally in the celebration. Sometimes, the smallest acts in the liturgy can touch our hearts in quiet and powerful ways.


Let us all grow in our understanding of what's really happening at that part of the Mass. These little moments matter more than we sometimes realize. Thank you and may God bless you and your families.
