



From Your Pastor

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus!

I've been thinking a lot about the recent canonizations in Rome and wanted to share a few reflections. Many of us watched the event online and witnessed a powerful moment of grace and hope for the Church. During his homily, Pope Leo spoke beautifully about Saints Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati. He emphasized that holiness is accessible and meant to be lived in everyday life, especially through the examples of these two new saints. Pope Leo reminded us that the saints show us how not to squander our lives, but to direct them upwards and make them masterpieces. One line that really hit me was when he said: the greatest risk in life is to waste it outside of God's plan.

These two new saints lived that message in such a real way. St. Carlo Acutis, who loved the Eucharist and used technology to share his faith, once said: *In front of the Eucharist, you become a saint*. This is a good reminder to all of us that holiness can continue to grow in our everyday lives. St. Pier Giorgio Frassati is known for his ability to serve the poor and create strong friendships. The Pope recalled how St. Pier Giorgio is often associated with the word "*Upwards*," referring to a famous photo of him climbing a mountain. This image beautifully expresses his constant striving toward God.

Neither of these new saints were looking for attention or praise. They did not waste their youth chasing comfort or success. They simply lived with joy and faithfulness. They had the courage to follow Christ and let Him guide their lives. That's what holiness is all about. It's not about being perfect but staying faithful in the small things each day. Whether it's at work, at home, or helping someone nearby, we are all called to take small steps of love and fidelity.

As we keep walking together in faith here at St. Mary, I really hope that the examples of St. Carlo and St. Pier Giorgio can encourage us all to live with that same boldness and joy. So let us try to say yes to God's will, one moment at a time. God bless you all.

St. Padre Pio was a Capuchin Franciscan Friar, who suffered much through his life – both physically and spiritually.

From his childhood, St. Pio felt himself called to God. Because of this, **St. Pio is the patron saint of adolescents**.



St. Pio was also a **stigmatist**. This means that – miraculously – St. Pio received the same **five wounds of Christ** during the Crucifixion: one wound on each of hand and foot, and a wound in the side.

St. Pio once said: "Pray, hope, and don't worry." He always trusted in God.
