St. Francis of Assisi

IS CELEBRATED ON OCTOBER 4TH.

St. Francis of Assisi was born to a wealthy Italian merchant family in the late 12th century, and lived in a sinful manner in his youth. After hearing God's voice, St. Francis slowly spent more time in prayer. God then told him, "Francis, repair my Church."

This led to St. Francis' decision to choose poverty and peace in his pure pursuit of God.

From then on, St. Francis encouraged people to return to God and His Church, during a period of scandal. Others who sought God followed St. Francis' way of life: <u>brotherhood by following the Gospel</u>. From this, the Franciscans were born.

This view of brotherhood – that **all living beings are God's creation** – is how St. Francis became the patron saint of animals.

His view of peace in God also brought us the <u>Prayer for Peace</u>. This prayer follows St. Francis' understanding of life and his desire to follow God as seen through the Gospel.



Pro-Life Testimony

When Ramona Trevino served as the manager of a Planned Parenthood facility in Sherman, Texas, she thought she was doing good.

"I thought I was helping women who were underinsured and in poverty, and I thought this was an alternative right – that this was a way they could receive healthcare that was affordable," she said. "It became more evident as the years passed that that's not what we were about."

Trevino, said she realized that her work with Planned Parenthood – ostensibly directed at women – was often targeted at teenage girls, including one as young as 12, who came to the clinic for birth control. "I know on the surface that doesn't sound like such a big deal," Trevino said, "but it is, because they are living a life of promiscuity, living irresponsibly, and when the birth control fails, they come back with their parents to seek advice."

Trevino remembered that God was tugging at her heart but she remained employed at Planned Parenthood.

Then several years ago, Trevino encountered a group of people who peacefully prayed for the conversion of hearts during a **40 Days for Life campaign** in her home state. The public witness of those at the vigil had a profound effect on Trevino. On day 3 of that campaign, she approached one of the praying women and asked for help, stating she did not want to work there anymore. She ultimately left her post and now is a national pro-life advocate for 40 Days for Life, returning to her Catholic faith.

She shares her message whenever she can:

"We're out on the sidewalk, we are placing our trust and we are surrendering to Jesus because we have no idea of the impact we are making on those around us, those who work inside these facilities, the women who are going in," she said. "We will never know the effect, and we're not meant to know because we would be so tempted to glorify ourselves and not glorify God, who deserves all the glory."






