

From Your Pastor

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus!

As I've shared with you before, we Rogationists have a special mission in the Church: to pray for and to promote vocations to the priesthood and religious life. This is at the very heart of who we are, and it comes straight from the words of Jesus: The harvest is great, but the laborers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His harvest. (Mt 9:37-38) I am really thankful that as a parish, we've already taken this mission to heart especially through our simple prayer: Send, O Lord, holy apostles into Your Church. Every time we say these words, we are not just saying a nice line, we are asking God from the heart to touch the lives of young men and women, and to call them to follow Him as priests or religious sisters and brothers.

But prayer is only part of it. We also need to stay open and to pay attention. Perhaps someone you know: your son, daughter, grandchild, sibling or friend has felt a quiet stirring in their heart a longing to serve God more deeply. These are sacred signs that God may be calling. If someone in your family expresses a desire to explore a vocation, support them, encourage them, walk with them and pray for them. Please don't be a stumbling block to God's invitation in their lives. Instead, be their first source of strength and joy as they discern the will of God.

And if you're a young person reading this, if you've felt something in your heart, something pulling you, don't ignore it. God often speaks in quiet ways, and He could be inviting you to something beautiful and bigger than yourself. Don't be afraid. Feel free to approach us, your priests. We are here to listen, guide, and help you discern. We can also connect you to our Vocations Director in the Diocese who can walk with you in this beautiful journey of discovery.

Let's keep praying together as a parish: *Send, O Lord, holy apostles into Your Church*. And as we pray, let's be open, supportive, and ready for the new vocations God is calling, maybe right here in our own community. God bless!

October is the Month of the Rosary

The Rosary is an **important and powerful prayer**, given to us by the Blessed Virgin Mary herself, as a gift to St. Dominic in the early 1200s. The Rosary was an answer to his prayers for help at the time.

The Rosary has also been a **tool used for protection against any and all foes**. In 1571, a Catholic fleet was being attacked by a strong opponent. St. Pope Pius V asked for all of Europe to pray the Rosary for the fleet's safety and victory. The Catholic fleet won! This victory took place in October of that year. Since then, October has been associated with the Rosary, specifically with the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7th).

The Rosary initially consisted of **fifteen Mysteries**. In 2002, St. Pope John Paul II added **five new Mysteries**.

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES FOCUS ON CHRIST'S EARTHLY BEGINNING.
THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES FOCUS ON CHRIST'S EARTHLY MINISTRY.
THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES FOCUS ON CHRIST'S PASSION.
THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES FOCUS ON CHRIST'S VICTORY OVER DEATH.

While the Rosary focuses on Christ's life, it begins and ends with our Blessed Mother.

The first Joyful Mystery is the Annunciation, where our Blessed Mother gave her "yes" to God's plan. The fifth and final Glorious Mystery is the Crowning of Mary Queen of Heaven, where she reigns with her Son, Jesus Christ.

Without our Blessed Mother, Christ's life – and our salvation – would not be possible.
