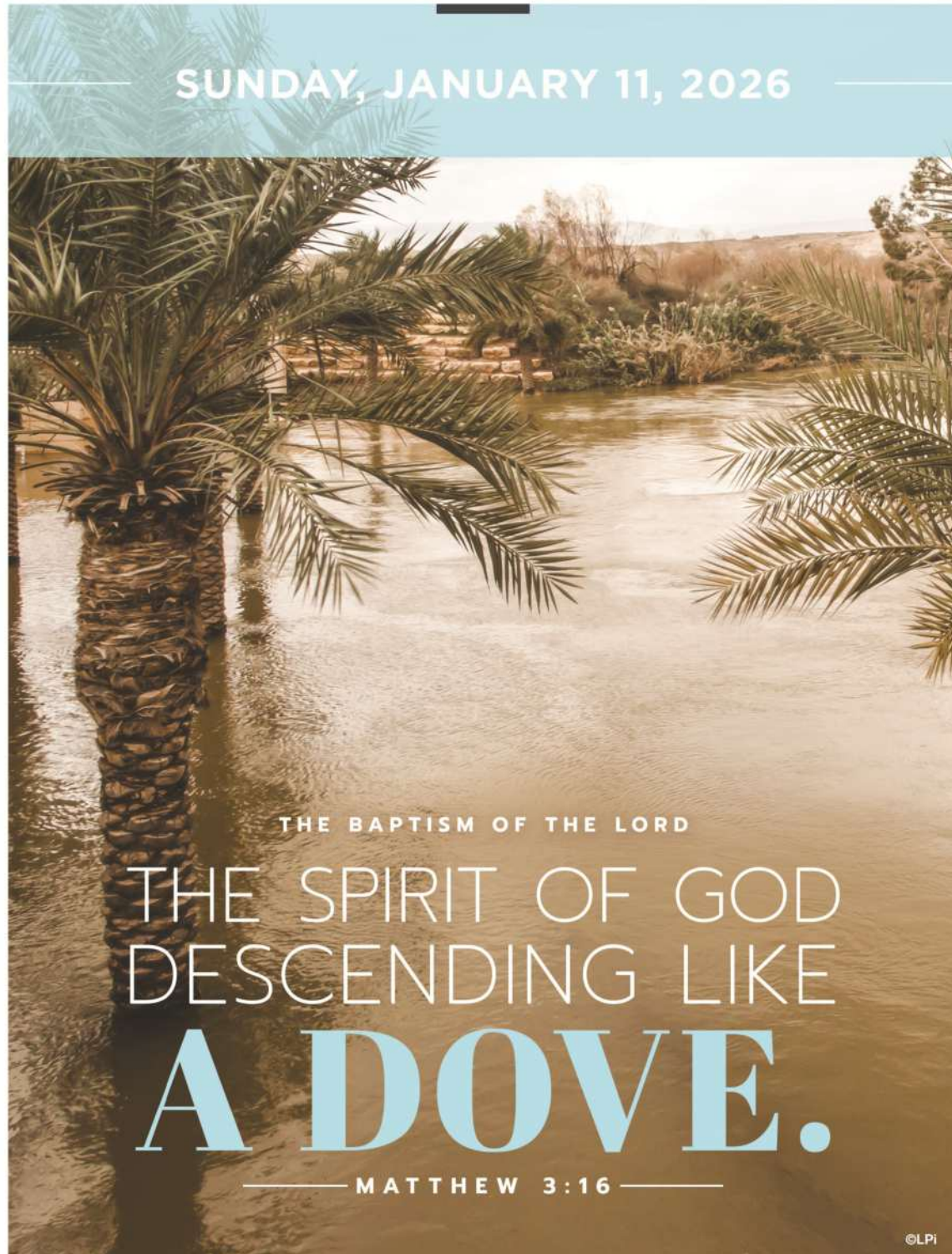

From Your Pastor

My dearest parishioners,

I greet you with love and peace in the name of Jesus!

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the moment when Jesus steps into the Jordan River and is revealed as God's beloved Son. As the Gospel tells us, the heavens were opened, the Spirit descended, and the Father's voice was heard: *You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.* But did you know that this feast is not only about Jesus? It is also about us. When we were baptized, God said the same thing to each one of us: *You are my beloved child.* That happened before we did anything special, before we made mistakes, before life became complicated. God chose us and loved us first.

This fact can be hard to remember in the middle of real life. Many of us come to Mass today overwhelmed by busy schedules, family worries, health concerns, financial stress, or quiet struggles no one else sees. Some of us feel tired, discouraged, or unsure if we are doing enough or being enough. This feast reminds us that our identity does not come from our successes, our failures, or what others think of us. *It comes from God, and that makes us special.*

Living our baptism means trying to remember that we are God's beloved children and letting that truth shape how we live: *It means choosing kindness when it is easier to be impatient, forgiving when it is hard, and showing up for one another here at St. Mary especially when someone is hurting or in need. It means trusting that God is at work in our everyday lives.*

This week, I invite you to take a simple moment to remember your baptism. Make the sign of the cross slowly. Thank God for calling you His beloved child, and ask for the grace to live faithfully as the person you were born to be. May this feast renew our hearts and strengthen our parish family as we continue to walk together in faith.

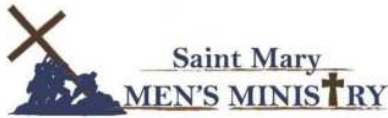


Mission Statement:

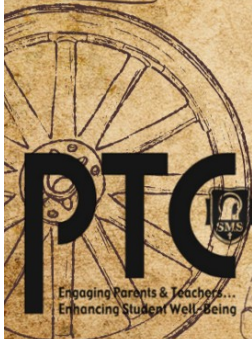

Stewardship Reflection

January 11, 2026 The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Today marks the close of the Christmas season, but before we return to Ordinary Time, we have one more great feast to celebrate — The Baptism of the Lord. Today's feast is a perfect opportunity to consider the privileges and responsibilities we all share as Christian stewards by virtue of our own Baptism.

At the moment of our Baptism, we became adopted sons and daughters of God, members of his holy, Catholic Church. Though we may not have realized it, the moment of our Baptism is also the moment we become Christian stewards, disciples of Jesus Christ, tasked with the work of following in His footsteps day by day and sharing the Gospel message with all those around us.

In our second reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Peter gives us a glimpse of the person of Jesus we should imitate. "He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him." We must live our lives like Jesus, seeking to do good to everyone we encounter; not just those in our inner circle of family and friends, but everyone in our community since the Father loves us all and Jesus sought out everyone with His saving message.

In the Gospel passage from Matthew, we see yet another aspect of Jesus in action, this time as he humbly stands before John to be baptized by him. What humility and what willingness to unite Himself to us our Lord demonstrates by this act. We can do no less as we live out our daily lives as his disciples.

And when we do strive with all our might to live out our Baptismal call to Christian stewardship, we will experience the deep honor of knowing that we, too, are God's "beloved" sons and daughters "with whom He is well-pleased."

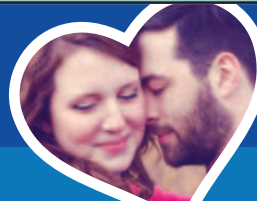

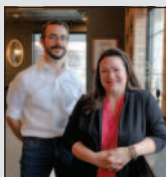
