

From Our Pastor



Question: What's the difference between priests and brothers, friars, etc.?



Answer: The distinctions titles and categories used for priests and the male members of religious communities can be confusing, especially since the categories can sometimes be intertwined as a man can be both a priest and a monk, or a brother and a friar. So, to help to piece the puzzle together, it's important to begin by noting some basic distinctions: The distinction between priests (who are ordained for sacramental ministry) and brothers (who are non -ordained members of religious communities and who are committed to lives of prayer and service).

Priests: A priest is a man who has been ordained for sacramental ministry and these fall into two categories: A) Diocesan (or Secular) Priests can either be attached to a diocese and who serve under a bishop. Their ministry is usually oriented toward pastoral service. B) Religious Priests are members of religious communities (like the Franciscans, Jesuits, Salvatorians, or Carmelites) and their lives are guided by the special mission and charism of their community. While both kinds of priest practice sacramental ministry, their spirituality and how they live out their priesthood can be very different.

Brothers: Brothers are non-ordained members of religious communities (such as those mentioned above) who live lives committed to prayer and service. Religious priests and brothers serve together in their communities and their ministries include much more than the care of parishes.

Monks, Friars, and Canons: These are broad categories that include religious priests and brothers, and each of these is connected to specific ways of life and spiritualities. ©LPi

From the Sacred Music Office:

I hope that everyone is having a blessed Lent. Today is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, also known as Laetare Sunday! The Latin word "laetare" which means "rejoice" is taken from the opening text of the Entrance Antiphon used this weekend, "Laetare Jerusalem" or "Rejoice Jerusalem". This Sunday signifies that we are half-way through the Lenten Season. As a sign of joy you will see our clergy in their rose vestments.

Since we are rejoicing this weekend, it is fitting to announce that our new organ is scheduled to be installed this week! This marvelous instrument has a wide variety of organ stops that allow an organist to play different styles of literature: American Eclectic, English Cathedral, French Romantic, and German Baroque. All of these variations can be used alone, or combined with the other organ styles. In total, this organ has 323 impressive sounds! I hope that you are excited for the beautiful music that will come from this new instrument in the very near future!

While we celebrate the arrival of the new organ, I would like to remind you that our fundraising efforts continue for new Church bells (the ones on the outside of the building) as well as additional music equipment for the choir area. Your continued support is crucial in helping us reach our goal and complete this important project. Thank you for your generous contributions and support of this fundraiser. Every contribution, no matter the size, makes a difference and brings us closer to making our dream a reality.

With the Triduum liturgies approaching, there will be something different included in the Stations of the Cross on Good Friday. Just like in past years, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 7pm. However, on Good Friday, our schola will be singing choral reflections throughout some of the stations. This solemn and reflective service will provide us with an opportunity to walk alongside Jesus on his journey to the cross, meditating on his ultimate sacrifice for our salvation.
