

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District (KWRD)
IEPA Loan Project No. L177632

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees of the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District (KWRD) will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, January 21, at 1:00 p.m. at the District Office, 1301 Sycamore Road, DeKalb, Illinois 60115.

The purpose of the hearing is to present an overview of the proposed Waterman–Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation (PBPN) Sanitary Service Extension Project and to provide an opportunity for public comment regarding potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project.

The project proposes to regionalize existing and future wastewater flows from the Village of Waterman and the Shab-eh-nay Reservation and convey those flows to the KWRD wastewater treatment system located in the City of DeKalb.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has issued a Project Summary and Preliminary Environmental Impacts Determination (PEID) for this project. Copies of this Notice, the Project Summary, and the Environmental Assessment are available for public inspection prior to the hearing and for ten (10) days following the hearing. Documents may be reviewed at the KWRD District Office, 1301 Sycamore Road, DeKalb, Illinois, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Written statements regarding the subject of the public hearing should be addressed to the IEPA or the loan applicant (KWRD), as indicated in the PEID document, within ten (10) days following the hearing.
