

Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District Remote Board Meeting Minutes Wednesday, October 6, 2021 – 12:00 PM

A Special Meeting of the Kishwaukee Water Reclamation District Board of Trustees was held held at the office of the District at 12:00 pm on Wednesday, October 6, 2021. In attendance were Trustees Dennis J. Collins, Dawn Cosentino, Attorney Keith Foster, District Manager Mark Eddington, District Engineer/Assistant Manager Mike Holland and Administrative Assistant Tracy Zenkner. - c) Notice of Intent to Award Mark Eddington recommended acceptance of the base bid from Berger Excavation and requests execution of the Notice of Intent to Award.
