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August Treasurer's Report

- 1. 7/16 purchased CD for the Bridge Fund, 401. \$12,255.29 for 1 year at 4.1% rate at Castle Rock Bank
- 2. I sold the CRB CD, valued at \$60,223.40 with accumulated interest of \$1,243.58 CD on 8-5 and repurchased a CD at CRB for \$61,466.98 at 4.1% for 1 year. This is not reflected in the Treasurer's numbers since it did not occur in July.
- The CTAS balance is \$1,942.13 and checking at Castle Rock Bank is \$1065.60. The difference is in the timing of the credit card payment and the recording of the claims in CTAS.
- 4. The 4M Fund is valued at \$264,765.29 and earned \$636.22 in interest at current interest rate of 4.254.
- 5. A new box was created on the Treasurer's report to indicate the amount our Town will need in the checking account to pay for the goods and services that we have accrued this month. It is calculated by adding the July wages (2,255) plus July claims (62,885.92) plus outstanding checks (235.43) plus a residual balance of \$7,500 for checking account safety, minus any uncleared deposits in CTAS (6,572.85). The calculation shows how much we have to sell from the 4M account to maintain the balance of roughly \$7,500 in checking. We can set any amount as a reserve in the checking account. It does not have to be 7500. It could be more or less. Any questions?
- 6. On July 22, \$130,000 was placed in the 4M account and divided into the 3 funds. General: 16,009.86, Roads and Bridges: 96059.11, and Fire Protection: 17931.03. Interest gained on the \$130,000 should be \$between \$150 and \$300.
- 7. The first Employer quarterly Information Report for the Minnesota Paid Leave Program was sent in July. It was not difficult but time consuming. CTAS may add a unit to ease the reporting.

Charge per therm that covers only the delivery costs of natural gas to a home or business through our distribution system. It does not include the charges for the natural gas itself.

Gas Affordability Program

A surcharge to recover the costs of offering a low-income customer co-pay program designed to reduce natural gas service disconnections. Billed to all non-interruptible customers

Gas Utility Infrastructure Costs

Minnesota law allows Xcel Energy to recover MPUC-approved costs of assessments, modifications, and replacement of natural gas facilities as required to comply with state and federal pipeline safety programs.

Heat Content Adjustment

Corrects for variances in the heating capability of natural gas, and the adjustment varies monthly. The higher the heat content, the lower the volume of natural gas needed to provide the same heating.

Natural Gas Innovation Act Costs

Minnesota law allows Xcel Energy to recover approved costs for pilot programs and technologies aimed at reducing natural gas emissions and helping meet the state's clean energy goals.

New Area Service/Extension Surcharge

Monthly charge for extending natural gas service to areas where the cost would otherwise have been prohibitive under Company's present rates and service extension policy.

Pressure Correction Adjustment

Adjusts for variances in the amount of natural gas measured by different types of meters due to pressure differences in the natural gas delivered to a service.

Resource Adjustment

This includes costs related to Conservation Improvement Programs, Gas Utility Infrastructure Costs and State Energy Policy Rider.

State Energy Policy

Minnesota law allows Xcel Energy to recover costs related to various energy policies approved by the Legislature.

Therm

A therm is a unit of heating value equal to 100,000 BritishThermal Units (BTUs). Since natural gas meters measure the volume of natural gas consumed in cubic feet, the Heat Content Adjustment is used to determine how much heat, in therms, is contained in the volume consumed.
