





- Call 811 or visit call811.com to request a locate and follow the instructions fully.
- · Mark with white paint or chalk the area you intend to dig.
- The waiting time varies by state so plan accordingly.
 Do not dig until you're notified that all locates are complete and the wait time has ended.
- Do not use mechanized equipment to expose the buried line.
 Dig carefully using hand tools to expose the buried line while observing and preserving the marks.
- Call 811 for reverification if you lose the markings or have questions.

CUSTOMER-OWNED LINES

Xcel Energy owns and maintains the natural gas piping from the street to our customers' gas meters, but as the property owner you are responsible for maintaining any natural gas lines from the meter outlet to gas appliances and equipment. In some cases, the meter may be located at your property line or a distance away from your home or business.





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

SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2025-01, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE A-2 AGRICULTURE BUSINESS DISTRICT, REGULATING ACCESS AND DRIVEWAYS, AND REGULATING CANNABIS AND HEMP BUSINESSES

On August 21, 2025, at a Meeting of the Greenvale Town Board, by majority vote, the Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 2025-01 which establishes the A-2 Agriculture Business District, regulates access and driveways, and regulates cannabis and hemp businesses:

- Establishing definitions related to cannabis businesses, hemp businesses, and schools; and
- Establishes the A-2 Agriculture Business District; and
- Renames the "A Agriculture District" to the "A-1 – Agriculture District"; and
- Establishing cannabis uses and hemp uses as interim uses in the A-2 - Agriculture District; and
- Establishing standards for access and driveways within the township; and
- Establishing general and use specific standards for cannabis businesses and hemp businesses.

HI Charles.

Sorry for my delay.

Ill start with the minimum maintenance statute. The Min. maintenance law says that a town board may designate a road as minimum maintenance if the road or segment of it is used "occasionally or intermittently for passenger and commercial travel."

https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/160.095 The standard then is whether a road segment receives only occasionally or intermittent use. Courts have not provided us with any further definition. So, its largely left to the discretion of the local board.

On the first issue, the concern you raise is that a minimum maintenance road is receiving use that is more than occasional or intermittent. The basis for this is that there is a resident living there, and use is more accurately described as frequent (daily) and regular. It's a reasonable interpretation that such a road segment could not by minimum maintenance on the part that receives the higher level of use.

However, the town board has to decide and justify their decision.

On the second issue: if the township maintains the road, and it is open in the winter, then the legal expectation is that the township must plow the road to provide access at the level of its use. If there is a home there used in the winter, the town needs to plow that road. Sincerely,
