Meeting Agenda

- 1. Call to order** 6:45 by Mark, **Pledge of Allegiance**
- 2. Committee Member Present:** Adam Royle, Mark Malecha, Dick Moore, Dave Roehl
- 3. Approve Agenda** Adam motioned to approve the agenda - Dick Second – carried unanimously
- 4. Town Hall Parking Lot** – Tony was going to get a second quote for the Parking lot that wasn't yet received. After reviewing the concept for additional parking it would be \$47,000 – they went back to the contractor on the existing parking lot from the Road to the first light pole which would be \$21,000 – continue it to field but not the north south portion would be an additional \$4,000 to finish – it includes the 18' pad that is in the grant – the bid for the cement only the lowest was \$18,000. In all of the quotes the elevation is wrong on the current slab from the door to the parking lot it has to be removed and they would have to meet the 2 surfaces to comply with wheelchair accessibility.

Will need to do the door work first and then make the decision on the door – Clerk to send a request to the state if we can do the door only and not do the items with the lot – The door is going to cost \$6800 so it is consuming more of the grant than was in the initial budget – the intention of the grant is to pay 50%

Moving the decision until they get final numbers for the door before they decide on the lot.

Mark motion that we table the decision; Adam seconded – carried unanimously

5. Filling Vacated Position

Tom Williams has resigned from the road commission – applications were received in April – Interviews to fill the vacancy will occur at the May Board meeting

Dick recommendation to select a younger person from the residents that applied

6. Culvert Replacement for Holyoke Avenue

Discussion:

Does it have anything to do with the DNR? We have confirmed the county and DNR have nothing to do with the waterway

There are ways to reline culverts. We will need to replace with a new one there is a washout under the culvert.

May have to look into whether there is a law that it has to be stamped – and there will be a weight restriction –

The contractor can typically replace it in a single day

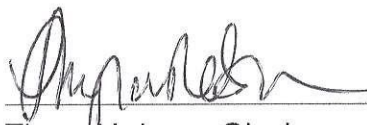
Committee will look into other places for sourcing the culvert and then they can select a contractor for the installation – the road has to stay at the same elevation.

Mark motion that we replace the culvert, but get additional pricing and go with the most economical version of the culvert, hoping for with \$10,000 for the culvert and \$30,000 for the whole project – Dick second – carried unanimously
