

## THE AUTUMN GIFT DAY



Autumn is often a time for stock-taking and we believe our Church Family is strengthening, our congregations are growing, as are our Life Groups. Our work with young children and families has been blessed by the arrival of our new Children's and Families minister. We continue to enjoy celebrating weddings and baptisms, and providing a familiar place for funerals at St Michaels. We are starting to do more in schools. We have exciting new plans being developed for our Vision 2030.

But all this costs money and it is only with your help that we can do what we believe God is calling us to be and to do.

As part of our stock taking we have prepared an estimate of our income and expenditure for the whole of this year. In total we estimate that we will spend around £234,000 this year. This is made up as follows:

Contribution to the cost of our clergy provided by the Diocese.	£103,000
(known as Parish Share)	
Church Office (salaries, pensions, phones, office rental etc.)	£56,000
Energy (heating and lighting)	£10,700
Children and Families Ministry (salary and resources)	£32,700
Church Fabric (extensive scaffolding for Moss Removal)	£13,500
Insurance, Cleaning and Other (various)	£18,100
TOTAL	£234,000

Our estimated income for the year is £210,000-£213,000 from donations from the Paris Giving Scheme, collections and fees from weddings and funerals.

Our estimated income is therefore £21,000-£24,000 less than our expenditure. This is no sudden shock. The PCC took a deliberate decision last year, in faith, that we needed to spend to maintain our important Children and Families Ministries work. But we now need your help to enable us to cover both this shortfall and to invest in the future as we develop our Vision 2030.
