His journey from rodeo arenas to the pulpit began when, at age 17, he lost a bull riding event, prompting him to surrender his life to Christ. Timothy has devoted his life to sharing the transformative power of Jesus—offering hope, healing, and purpose to those who are struggling. Tim's story holds a theme of perseverance that has ministered to so many and bears the mantra that "God is into turning one's mess into one's message."

Joseph Kebbie - Trans World Radio

Joseph Kebbie serves as the Africa Director for Your Network of Praise overseeing the New Life Africa Satellite Network. His ministry, Men of Courage, focuses on digital outreach to Muslims in West Africa. Growing up as a refugee across West Africa during the Liberian war, Joseph experienced how radio could be a lifeline, bringing crucial news and hope in dark times. He believes that the Gospel, when shared in a person's own language, speaks more intimately and has the power to transform lives at the deepest level. Joseph is honored to share Christ's message in ways that resonate across languages and cultures, praying that God's word reaches the hearts of people in every corner of the continent.

Speaker: Patrick Klein, Vision Beyond Borders Topic: "The Earth is the Lord's – Psalm 24:1"

Patrick Klein is the founder and Executive Director of Vision Beyond Borders. After serving as a missionary in China, Pat was motivated to supply God's Word in restricted nations. Pat has visited over sixty countries in his ministry work. Along the way he has dodged rocket attacks in Kabul, Afghanistan, prayed in North Korea, been arrested in Morocco, and been banned from China. He's ministered to orphaned children living in sewers in Romania, brought aid to women escaping sex trafficking in India and Nepal, and delivered Christmas presents to children fleeing war in Burma. Pat still loves getting Bibles to people all over the world. He's thankful for God's Word and that he can start every day with a Bible and a heart to seek Jesus. He says he's challenged when he sees the huge task of sharing the Gospel in every nation — but he knows that God is much bigger and He can do anything.

A. Topic: "Africa: A Sustainable, Multiplying Harvest of Men"
Speaker: Wayne Craig, Trans World Radio/Every Man a Warrior

Wayne Craig joined the Every Man a Warrior ministry of TWR in 2020. Wayne loves to disciple and walk beside men as they learn how to live the Great Commandment and Great Commission. By God's grace and provision, Wayne's ministry has expanded from North Dakota and Africa to include the northwest as the Every Man a Warrior N.W. Director. His primary responsibilities are to assist church leadership in the northwest of the US, continue to develop leaders in Africa, and develop team leaders in the Boise, Idaho area as the ministry expands to local churches, prisons and universities in the Treasure Valley.



B. Topic: "Before You Board - A Look at Cross-Cultural Preparedness" Speakers: Corey & Cassondra Vaughan, Ethnos360



Corey and his wife Cassondra, serve at Ethnos360's missionary training center in Central Missouri. At the training center, they are involved in many aspects of equipping and preparing missionary candidates before they go to the field, such as teaching, and discipling, helping coordinate mobilization visits and events, and working with financial partners whose funding helps to keep the ministry going.

In this session, Corey and Cassondra will discuss how passion will get you to the mission field, but it won't keep you there. Nor will excellent training or the latest mission trends

and strategies. Nothing apart from a deep abiding relationship with Jesus Christ, will keep you engaged in this line of work for the duration needed to complete the task. Imagine arriving on a foreign mission field for the first time, not knowing what to do. Where would you start? How do you begin to learn another language? There are so many questions we don't even think to ask, unless we slow down, learn from those who have gone before us and prepare ourselves for the battle we are stepping into.

C. Topic: "Watching the Wave"

Speaker: Benjamin Seeberger, ERRChina

Benjamin Seeberger lived and worked in China for two decades in higher education as a lecturer, teacher, and in university leadership. He is passionate about the integration of Christianity with the soul of Chinese society, both on practical and intellectual levels. As a practicing historian, he is also fascinated with how Christ has already transformed China throughout history and prepared the soil for a new revival in the 21st century.

God is preparing a great wave of revivals for China, even amid a growing 21st-century dystopian surveillance state, increased antagonism with the United States and Western culture, and whispers of war from across the South China Sea. Join this timely seminar to



discover strategies for uncovering these signals of revival from abroad and learn how Educational Resources and Referrals -China (ERRC) is equipping a new generation to reach China's ever-growing army of intellectuals for Christ in preparation for this mighty harvest.

This is work that Chris previously led for World Vision's three Africa Regions, and of which he has been a principal architect. This work takes aim at the critical problems of both entrenched poverty and the effects of rapidly changing environmental challenges. It sits on the foundation of building the empowered world view needed to overcome endemic dependency.



Nathan Shenk, Interserve

Nathan and Lorna Shenk are missionaries with Interserve USA, an international Missions organization, whose vision is to "send Christian professionals to the Arab and Asian worlds." Nathan worked as the organization's medical supply & logistics director from 2015 through early 2020. His ministry was interrupted by Covid and marriage to Lorna (a Filippino) in March 2020. They attempted to return to the country where they had both served, but were denied entry into the country, due to new Covid regulations. They lived in the Philippines for just over two years until Lorna received her U.S. visa in late 2022. They reside in Minnesota while on Home Assignment, working toward redeployment by the end of the year.





AJ Hawkins, Village Ministries International

After serving in many capacities with the ministry over the years, A.J. became the Director of Operations for Village Ministries International (VMI) in 2022. He oversees the day-to-day functions of the office while coordinating and implementing all international activities. VMI has missionaries serving in 22 countries across the globe with 17 of those having ongoing opposition against Christians. The purpose of VMI is two faceted: provide theological material and training to equip rural village pastors who do not have access to Bible training and second, provide respite care and encouragement to Christian front-line workers who endure daily persecution for their faith.


Speaker: Mark Mittelberg

Topic: ""Press On: Five Keys to Mission Success"





Mark Mittelberg, a Minot, ND native, is an international speaker and the bestselling author of nearly 30 books and published pieces, focusing in the areas of apologetics, evangelism, and evangelistic leadership. His most recent is the all-new book, Contagious Faith: Discover Your Natural Style for Sharing Jesus with Others, and the 6-week video training course by the same name. Prior to that he was the primary author of the Becoming a Contagious Christian training course (with Lee Strobel). This course was translated into more than 20 languages and helped about 2,000,000 people around the world share Christ in natural ways. He also wrote the leadership-oriented, Becoming a Contagious Church, which presents an innovative blueprint for church-based evangelism. Mark's published pieces have sold a total of some three million copies. Mark's father, Mitt, served on the STEER board for 24 years.
