Data Collection and Use

STEER, Inc. collects personal information for the purpose of supporting our nonprofit's mission. The types of data we may collect include:

Device and usage Information	To help target right audiences	Retained for 1 year
Mobil Information	Text communications, events, news	Retained until opt-out
Payment Information	To process donations or event fees	Retained for 1 year

We will use the information provided to communicate with you, fulfill donations, manage volunteers, and promote our activities.

Data Sharing and Third-Party Services

We do not sell, trade or rent your personal information to third parties for marketing or promotional purposes. We may share your personal data with thirdparty service providers to help us operate efficiently. These third parties include payment processors, email marketing platforms, and event management services. We ensure that all third-party services comply with relevant data protection standards.

Mobile information will not be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. All the above categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.

Data Security and Protection

STEER, Inc. takes appropriate measures to safeguard your personal data from unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. We use encryption, secure servers, and other security measures to protect your information, and we regularly review our practices to ensure continued protection.

Our services are not directed to individuals under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children.
