Once interest has been registered the candidate must meet the following:

- **Have been born in the Western Isles or been resident in the Western Isles for the period of 12 consecutive months prior to the date of the Games opening ceremony. See IIGA Operational Guidelines Section 6 for clarification.**
- **Must meet any of the above qualification times at least twice, at District or National Level Competitions, between 1st August 2021 and 31st March 2022.**
