QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR SHOOTING

Those wishing to put themselves forward for selection in the WIIGA 2027 Betri International Island Games **Clay Target Shooting Team**, competitions to be held in Faroe Islands 3rd -9th July 2027 must register an interest with the **Shooting Team Manager, Archie MacVicar**, no later than 30th June 2026 by: -

The disciplines will be as follows: -

Discipline	Team Event	Individual Event
ISU Skeet	2 x 100 targets	2 x 125 targets
Automatic Ball Trap	2 x 100 targets	2 x 125 targets
Olympic Trap	2 x 100 targets	2 x 125 targets
English Skeet	2 x 100 targets	2 x 125 targets

Once interest has been registered the candidate must meet the following: -

♦ **Have been born in the Western Isles or be resident in the Western Isles for the period of 12 consecutive months prior to the date of the games opening ceremony. See IIGA Operational Guidelines section 6 for clarification.**

♦ **Must hold a current valid shotgun certificate for shotgun/s being taken to games.**

♦ Submit a minimum of 5 scores to be considered for qualification in your registered discipline.

These scores must be from 100 bird shoots, 2 of which may be from your club ground and the 3 remaining will have to be from SCTA or CPSA selection shoots at 2 different registered shooting grounds.

In the event of more shooters being available than places, the highest scoring contestants will be given preference for selection. In the event of a tie over the best 5 scores a 6th & if necessary further scores will be taken into consideration.

Once selected, team members must commit to participate in a preparation plan which must consist of at least 5 registered shoots in their discipline during the run in to departure for the games, at which a minimum qualification scores will be expected.

♦ Discipline qualification minimum scores: -

ISU Skeet	65
Automatic Ball Trap	80
Olympic Trap	80
English Skeet	85

Scores can be taken from the period 1st Jan 2026 to the selection cut off date which will be 31st Dec 2026.

As there are ample selection shoots in the calendar this year selection scores must be from the relevant discipline: -

ISU Skeet	ISU Skeet only
ABT	ABT only
Olympic Trap	OT only
English Skeet	ESK only

It is hoped to make up a team consisting of trap & skeet shooters to cover the available entry slots.

Prospective team members must ensure that they are able to secure the period of the Games (3rd - 9th July 2027) as time off from their workplace. Be aware that travel arrangements may require the team to travel outside these dates.

All team members will be expected to be familiarise themselves with the IIGA Shooting bylaws and the rules for the discipline that they wish to participate in, as when at competition they will be expected to take their turn at referee/scorer.

Please Note: The Island Games is an elite level competition, achieving qualifying standards, particularly B standards, does not guarantee selection to the squad. In some cases the number of athletes is restricted by the IGA individual sports by-laws, but you should also be aware that the total squad will ultimately be determined by the WIIGA Committee. The main considerations for the committee will be the overall size and standard of the squad along with the costs and logistics of travel & accommodation.
