



Inavale Farm (two!) One-Day Horse Trials June 6 & 7, 2026

These are two separate events, with all three phases each day. The cross country courses will be the same both days, with different show jumping courses.

Classes (will be split as entries warrant):

1) Training

Sat: dressage test 2026 USEF Training test A, jumps max 3'3"

Sun: dressage test 2026 USEF Training test B

2) Novice

Sat: dressage test 2026 USEF Novice test A, jumps max 2'11"

Sun: dressage test 2026 novice test B

3) Beginner Novice

Sat: dressage test 2026 USEF Beginner Novice test A, jumps max 2'8"

Sun: dressage test 2026 beginner novice test B

4) Starter

Sat & Sun: dressage test 2026 USEA Starter Test A, jumps max 2'3", water optional

5) Grasshopper

Sat/Sun: dressage test 2023 USDF Intro Test A, jumps max 16", no water, ditches, or combinations

Cross Country Courses: May be modified (shorter and with less jumping efforts than USEA recognized event standards). Courses may include ditches, water, banks appropriate to level (no bank, water optional for intro). Cross country courses open for walking after Friday 4:00 pm.

Arenas and Footing: Dressage, show jumping, and warmup all on grass or sand arena, depending on weather. Cross country footing grass. Cross country distances may be modified for safety.

Awards: prizes to first, second, third, ribbons to fifth place, classes may be divided.

Attire: approved hard hats with chin strap required for xc and sj, protective vest required for xc.

Entries: Checks to Inavale Farm. Visa, MC accepted, enter online.

Refunds: Full refund if cancellation received by May 23rd (must call or email secretary). Between May 23rd and May 31st, \$50 refund, after May 31st **no refund**. Full refund if event is cancelled. Full refund any time if spot can be filled from secretary's wait list.

Double entries: Because this is a schooling event, one horse may compete in two classes with different riders.

Stabling: limited covered portable stalls \$55 (24 hrs) or uncovered corrals \$30 (24 hrs). Straw bedding provided. No stabling available for horses not competing the next day. Stalls must be cleaned on departure. Camping permitted on grounds. Horse stabling not provided by organizer *must* be approved in advance: hoofprints@inavalefarm.com

Dogs: must be on leash, or day care available on grounds, kennel (541)929-4482

Ride times: will be posted on website www.startboxscoring.com June 3rd. Order of Go will be Training to Grasshopper in all phases. Recheck ride times on Saturday at check-in.

Schooling: Will not be available on Friday before event (early arrivals may hack in field and outdoor arena, but may not jump). Schooling may be available (weather permitting) after competition each day, for horses who have already competed. Check with secretary on arrival.

Directions: From I-5 exit 228 toward Corvallis (Hwy 34). Follow signs toward Philomath/Ocean Beaches. In Philomath turn left (south) on 13th street (2nd stoplight). Four miles to Airport Road, right on Airport. Then right at fork (gravel, still Airport Road), Right on Sexton Road. Look for parking sign off Sexton Road.
