



Policy Title:	Darwin Basketball Stadium Venue Terms and Conditions	Version:	1.1

1. Purpose

This policy sets out the terms and conditions that apply to entry to and use of Darwin Basketball Stadium (the Venue), operated by Basketball NT (BNT). It aims to ensure the safety, fair treatment and appropriate conduct of all persons using the Venue.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all hirers, teams, players, coaches, officials, spectators, parents and guardians, contractors and other visitors who enter or use Darwin Basketball Stadium for any purpose.

3. Booking and Access

- Use of any court, room or area of the Venue must be booked and confirmed through BNT in advance in line with the BNT Court Hire Policy.
- Access is limited to the confirmed booking period only.
- BNT may vary or reallocate a booking where required for competition, safety or venue operations.

4. Code of Behaviour

All persons on site must comply with the Basketball NT Codes of Behaviour (Conduct) at all times while at the Venue. BNT may remove, suspend or exclude any person who breaches the Codes or acts in a manner that endangers others or brings the Venue or BNT into disrepute.

5. Health, Safety and Supervision

- All persons must follow venue safety signage, staff directions and emergency evacuation procedures.
- Minors must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Hirers are responsible for the conduct and safety of their group.
- Footwear is required to be worn at all times.

6. Care of Facility and Equipment

The Venue and any equipment provided must be left in the condition in which they were found. Users are liable for the cost of repair or replacement of any damage caused during their use of the Venue.

7. Prohibited Conduct

- Alcohol may only be consumed where expressly authorised by BNT.
- The Venue is smoke and vape free.
- Weapons, illicit substances, unauthorised commercial activity and any dangerous or offensive items are prohibited.



8. Liability and Insurance

To the extent permitted by law, BNT accepts no liability for any loss, damage, injury or theft arising from use of the Venue. Hirers and users attend and participate at their own risk and are encouraged to hold appropriate public liability insurance.

9. Photography, Filming and Streaming

BNT may photograph, film or livestream activity at the Venue for promotional, broadcast or competition purposes. By attending, individuals consent to incidental capture of their image, subject to BNT's Privacy Policy.

The Pixellot video service operates on all courts within Darwin Basketball Stadium, with all games being recorded and streamed.

10. Cancellations and Variations

BNT may cancel, reschedule or vary a booking due to weather, safety concerns, competition requirements or circumstances beyond its control, and will provide reasonable notice where practicable.

11. Enforcement and Breach

Failure to comply with this policy, including the Basketball NT Codes of Behaviour (Conduct), may result in:

- Immediate removal from the Venue
- Suspension or termination of a booking
- Suspension or banning from future use of the Venue
- Legal action where applicable
