### Guidelines

- The declaration form must be completed and submitted with the infographic file in the specified format. E-mail to [enquiries@eventmanagementdirect.co.uk](mailto:enquiries@eventmanagementdirect.co.uk) by 23/01/26
- Infographic submissions should be non-interactive and will be displayed on a large screen
- Judging will be based on the following criteria: Originality; Creativity and use of graphics; Overall visual appeal; Relevance to preoperative assessment; Ease of interpretation.
- Infographics must be your original work. AI may be used for design inspiration but must not be used to generate the infographic or its content.

Due to high volumes of submissions or limited presentation space, it may not always be possible to accept all infographics submitted for presentation at the Conference. Under these circumstances infographics scoring most highly (in ranked order) following independent peer review will be offered the opportunity to present. The Preoperative Association is unable to provide peer review feedback on any submissions not accepted for presentation.

All presenters must pay for registration at the meeting; travel and accommodation will not be reimbursed by the Preoperative Association. Non-members of The Preoperative Association are welcome to make submissions, but will be required to pay the standard non-member registration fee if selected to present at the conference.
