Wickline Scholarship

Established in 2009, to assist women 22 years of age+ pursuing a post-secondary education. **In 2025, 4 local students received a total of \$13,000.**

Lighthouse Fund

Helping uninsured or underinsured women & children on the western slope since 2013 with medical or dental assistance. **In 2025, 49 women & children received a total of \$21,587 in care supported by Lighthouse.**
