



Not since the IPA explosion of the late aughts has a style of beer experienced such a meteoric rise to dominance.

In the space of just a few years, hazy went from just the latest adopted American beer trend to the most popular style of craft beer around.

This unprecedented popularity all but dictated that brewers needed to get aboard the hazy train, regardless of what they may think of the style. These days you can pick a craft brewery out of a hat and just about guarantee they'll do one (if not several).

Only this year has the rise of hazy beer shown signs of levelling off, gaining only a handful of additional entries in the recent New World Beer and Cider Awards. After the Brewers Guild Awards later in the year we'll know for sure, but even if the plateau has finally been reached, hazy is still sitting on an absolutely titanic slice of the craft market.

However, as the years of hazy saturation have worn on, a growing number of drinkers are finding themselves well and truly over the style. Over the bar, the once ubiquitous refrain of "Got any hazys?" is gradually shifting to "Got anything else?"

Whether you're over it or still all-in, hazy beer isn't going anywhere any time soon, so you might as well be getting the good stuff. Hazy, just like any other style, has good and bad examples. Generally speaking, the overall quality has increased significantly just in the last year or two, as more brewers figure out the eccentricities of these challenging beers. But there's still plenty out there that seems like it's been brewed as an afterthought and chucked out onto the market just to capitalise on the popularity of the style. Lazy Hazy I call it. Dull, murky tasting beer with plenty of haze, but no life or character to the flavour.

So how to aim for a good one? First know what you're getting. The principle split in the styles of hazy beer is whether or not they've had lactose (unfermentable milk sugar) added. Lactose introduces a sweetness and weight to the body of a beer, and while these milkshake style hazys certainly have their following, they're absolutely not for me. So, if you're not after a sweet, heavy beer either then check if lactose has been added. It should be declared on the packaging of most examples.

Lactose aside, good hazy beer should (despite its appearance) have a brightness to its aroma and flavour. A sharp acidity that holds those fruit flavours up and keeps them tasting fresh and crisp.

Without that sharpness and lift, all that fruitiness can end up tasting muted, overripe and squishy.

Another trap hazys often fall into is lack of bitterness. While hazy is a low bitterness beer, it shouldn't be a no bitterness beer, and without that bit of grip to conclude the finish, the drinkability can suffer.

As long as those two boxes are ticked, you've likely got a perfectly sound beer. Whether it's also an interesting beer depends on a myriad of other factors, including personal taste, but it's a good foundation to keep in mind as you're exploring.

As discussed, there is a lot of hazy beer out there. But I have a few highly available go-to's that are easy recommendations. Mac's Apparition is a remarkably good budget option in a six pack, as is Panhead Sandman for a craftier but still affordable pick. If you're aiming closer to the top shelf, Behemoth Me Time Mozaic and Garage Project's single batch Fresh IPA are some of the very best I've tasted.

The Story of a One-Off Ferrari Icon

hen most think of a vehicle with the name "Bread Van" naturally the image of, well, a van filled with bread, pastries, cakes and other goodies from

a local bakery spring to mind. Mention Bread Van to a Ferrari fan and they will think of only one vehicle. A 1962 Ferrari 250 GT SWB, chassis number 2819GT.

With its shark nose, flat roofline and that squared off rear, this one-off Ferrari 250 GT Short Wheelbase was given the nickname "Bread Van" by the European Press. It saw action at Le Mans and Brands Hatch as part of the 1962 Sports Car World Championship and is up there today with its 250 GTO counterpart as one of the most valuable Ferraris of all time.

The Bread Van's story can be traced back to the dawn of the 1960s and the famous walkout of numerous Ferrari employees. What became known as the "palace revolt" many of Enzo Ferrari's top engineers and designers walked out after being dissatisfied with II Commendatore's sometimes brutal management style and continued interference in Scuderia Ferrari from Enzo's wife Laura Garello.

As a result, team manager Romolo Tavoni, engineer Carlo Chiti and designer of what would be the all-conquering 250 GTO, Giotto Bizzarrini, all left Ferrari and joined Count Giovanni Volpe's Scuderia


Serenissima privateer racing team. The story goes that when old Enzo got wind of this, the team's order for a new 250 GTO was promptly cancelled. As a result, the team had to look elsewhere for a competitive car.

Fortunately, they were able to get hold of a development 250 GT SWB which Bizzarrini set to work converting to GTO specification. The 3.0L V12 was set lower to improve the centre of gravity and they threw in dry sump lubrication. The plan was to take chassis number 2819GT to Le Mans in 1962, so the car would have to be fairly aerodynamic to achieve those high speeds down the old Mulsanne Straight. Piero Drogo penned the lines and 2819GT was ready to contest the Le Mans.

Sadly, four hours into the race, the Bread Van retired allowing the factory 250 GTOs to emerge victorious in their class. However, the one-off Ferrari achieved a class win at Brands Hatch the same year, but that was the extent of its motorsport victories as the car was withdrawn and used for regular road use. Bizzarrini went on to design the first Lamborghini V12 and Carlo Chiti would become head of Alfa Romeo's racing department.

As for the Bread Van, it started a new life competing in historic racing events throughout the later half of the 20th century. In 2010, the car was refurbished and given a certificate of authenticity by Ferrari Classiche. It has been a familiar site at events like the Goodwood Revival and Le Mans Classic in recent years.

Sadly the Bread Van was involved in crash while negotiating a chicane on the Mulsanne Straight while contesting the 2022 Le Mans Classic. Driver, 31-year-old Lukas Halusa emerged unscathed but the Bread Van sustained







heavy impact damage. With a repair bill likely to be in the millions, this estimated \$30 million-dollar

one-off Ferrari will likely be out of action for some time. Let's hope we get to see this icon turning a wheel in anger soon .

One of my cherished memories growing up was time spent with my nana (R.I.P.) and the yummy food that she would prepare for us grandkids, in particular I was very fond of her fry breads, with lashings of butter, homemade Black Doris plum jam and a cup of hot Milo - simply put "soul food!"

In this article I am going to share this family favourite and whilst not directly barbecue related, fry breads are a great side or as an alternative to the traditional burger bun and are a real crowd pleaser no matter how served.

LET'S GET STARTED...

Time: 1 hour Makes 8

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Tbsp Standard flour
- 1 Tbsp White sugar
- 1 Tbsp Active yeast

- 1 Cup Milk
- 1 Cup Hot water
- 4 Cups Standard flour Canola oil for frying

METHOD:

Add the first measure of flour and sugar to a bowl, add milk and warm water. Mix together until combined.

Add active yeast and set aside for 10 minutes. The yeast mixture will bubble and when fully activated resemble a soft sponge in appearance.

- Add the second measure of flour to another large bowl and slowly add the yeast mixture. Fold together until combined and gently kneed till smooth you may need to add a little extra flour to ensure the dough is not "wet".
- Cover and set aside in a warm part of **Ū**■ the kitchen for 45mins. The dough will double in size.
- Heat the frying oil to 175c. (I use a large electric frying pan for this with approximately 4cms/4lts of Canola oil)
- Once the dough has doubled, turn out onto a lightly floured surface and roll to a thickness of approximately 2cms. With a long knife cut in to desired portions - 6x6cm square will yield 8 pieces.
- Set aside for 15mins to proof the dough further.
- When the oil has reached 175c, gently lower the dough into the oil and cook until both sides are golden brown (5 or so minutes).
- Remove breads, place onto a cake rack and rest for 5 minutes.

Peter Morfee is the principal technical advisor for Energy Safety. His extensive experience in electrical regulation has overseen major legislative changes as New Zealand moved from a prescriptive to a risk based regulatory system.

hese changes were necessary to allow New Zealand to join the expanding global marketplace and to provide regulatory mechanisms to safely utilise new and emergent technologies.

Mr Morfee's views on where electricity regulatory practices are heading and how emerging risks may be addressed paint a picture for the future:

Proficient practitioner skills will be a premium as new technologies are phased in offsetting the use of our more established liquid, gas and solid fuel energy sources.

While it might not become the reality (we're still waiting for the flying cars which were so prevalent in science fiction media decades ago), imagine with me this possible future:

You drive your electric vehicle (EV) to the supermarket to buy groceries for the week. One of the specials includes reduced-price electricity you can take back home and use to cook your food.

While we tend to think of the EV as a mode of transportation, we should also consider

possible to charge the batteries at optimal times in different locations then transport and supply electricity to a location where it is best utilised.

The supermarket car park you drove to in this future is under an overhead cover formed by arrays of photovoltaic (PV) panels. These panels generate and supply electricity for the building and charge the customers EV batteries while they are shopping.

When you return home, you simply "plug in" the EV flexible cord to your house power inlet. The stored energy (from your "home battery on wheels") is reversed and supplies electricity to the main switchboard which is then used to provide energy for cooking, lighting and heating the household.

Some of these elements may not even be that far off with reported trials of this emerging technology which has the potential to provide stored energy resilience to New Zealand's power network and assist to buffer peak demand.

The weekend promises to be busy with a family BBQ. Your future BBQ might use a

the small wind generator on the roof. The hydrogen can be stored, used to heat the house during winter or converted back to electricity using a fuel cell.

Some of the things we're thinking about are - if we take next generation motor vehicles, we know these will require far less maintenance and have autonomous safety features making them safer.

Future vehicles utilising hydrogen and battery powered electrical energy will have effective pollution reduced to zero.

EV also has the advantage that it can be used to store, supply, and move electricity around to where it can be optimally utilised.

Applying regulations and standards

If you are installing or working on some piece of fancy, unfamiliar electrical equipment, for which no standard is cited, ensure you apply the (Safety Fundamental Principles) contained in Part 1 of the Australian / New Zealand Wiring Rules and always look for guidance and recently issued Standards for advice.

Using the provisions of an updated Standard where an earlier version of that standard is currently cited in the Electrical (Safety) Regulations 2010 may be considered as reasonably practicable steps to improve or enhance the safety of any completed work provided that compliance with the cited Standard is still achieved. Reference to the updated Standard should be included on any certification together with the cited Standard.

Energy Safety has published guidance on EV charging stations which is available on the WorkSafe Energy Safety website.

TOM LONG - GOLF PROFESSIONAL





common mistake that many amateurs make is attempting to lift the golf ball into the air to attain elevation. With a 6 iron through to the wedges it's important to create a 'ball- first then turf' impact sequence.

This correct type of impact 'traps' the ball between two solid surfaces (clubface and the ground) forcing it forward whilst 'spinning it-up' the clubface thus creating backspin and elevation.

The two most common reasons why players 'thin the golf ball' are:

An incorrect ball position - 'Too far forward' in the stance will often result in the ball being struck on the upswing 'raising the strike' - If you consistently 'thin' the ball, try moving the ball an inch further back in your stance. (See pic 1 - pink ball is incorrect ball position for 7 iron white ball is correct)

Releasing the club too early with the hands in the downswing - A release that occurs too early in the downswing causes the clubhead to overtake the hands prior to impact which 'raises' the strike and presents the leading edge to the cover of the ball.

Pic 2 Shows a downswing in which the hands have released the 'wrist hinge' created during the backswing 'too-early' you will see that the left arm and hands are behind the clubhead at impact - I refer to players who make this mistake as 'Flippers'

Pic 3 If you are a 'Flipper', then this image shows the position that I want to convert you to - the left arm and wrists are ahead of the clubhead leading into the impact position and will deliver a descending blow onto the ball first before striking the turf.

Hit 20 balls with your 7 iron attempting to keep the handle ahead of the clubhead for as long as possible into impact. Doing so will deliver a descending blow (a ball-first then ground impact) If you manage to prevent the release of your hands until after impact the ball flight produced should be low and slightly to the right of your target – your goal is to produce 20 consecutive low punch-shots that finish to the right of your target. After 20 shots, revert to hitting 10 balls normally without this thought process in mind ... By repeating this drill pattern over and over again, you should find that the release of the hands and clubhead will happen later in the downswing leading to the correct compression of the golf ball and fewer 'thinned' golf shots.

The Nürburgring is a legendary motorsport complex located in Nürburg. Germanv.

t is known for its challenging and ultracomplex layout, which includes the 20.8 km long Nordschleife (North Loop) track, nicknamed 'The Green Hell'. It has a rich history in motorsports, having hosted numerous prestigious races (including the German Grand Prix and F1), and yet is also open to the public for tourist drives and track days. The track's unique design, combined with its onerous reputation has made it a favourite among enthusiasts and professional drivers alike.

The Nürburgring's history dates back to the 1920s when the German government commissioned the construction of a new racetrack in the Eifel Mountains. It's believed that the track was essentially constructed to alleviate unemployment and with that in mind, around 25,000 people were used to build it. Overall, the project cost around 14 million Reichsmarks, (or the equivalent of a cool \$50 million to you and me).

Designed by German architect Hermann Tilke, construction of the Nürburgring began in 1925 and was completed in 1927. The layout itself consisted of two separate tracks, the Nordschleife (North Loop) which was originally 22.9km and featured over 170 corners and 'significant' elevation changes; and the Südschleife (South Loop), a shorter 7.7 km track that was used for smaller races.

With the racetrack's complicated configuration, it quickly gained a reputation as one of the most challenging and dangerous circuits in the world, a statement backed up by the fact that it claimed many lives during its early years. It is estimated that around 70 drivers, both professional and amateur, have died on the Nürburgring Nordschleife track alone, however, the exact number is difficult to determine as there are thought to be many unrecorded accidents and fatalities.

The extremely high fatality rate and 'other' safety concerns eventually led to the closure of the Südschleife in 1971, but in the 1980s, a new modern Grand Prix circuit was built at the Nürburgring, which then went on to host its first Formula One race in 1984. Not only did the Grand Prix circuit replace the old Südschleife but was much safer than the Nordschleife, although the Nordschleife is still used today for various racing events and continues to be a popular destination for automotive enthusiasts.

Despite the obvious potential to be broken at any moment, the 5 minutes and 19.546 seconds lap record for the Nürburgring Nordschleife track has held firm for the past 5 years. It was set on June 29, 2018, by the Porsche 919 Hybrid Evo race car driven by Timo Bernhard, a German racing driver. This lap time shattered the previous record of 6 minutes and 11.13 seconds, which was set by Stefan Bellof in a Porsche 956 race car in 1983. However, it's probably worth noting that the lap record can only be set during specific timed events or manufacturer test sessions.

Being one of the most iconic racetracks in the world, means that many notable racing drivers have competed there over the years. Jim Clark (considered one of the greatest drivers of his era) won the German Grand Prix at the Nürburgring in 1963 and 1965 and fellow Scotsman

Jackie Stewart won the German Grand Prix three times there during the 1960s and 1970s.

Niki Lauda infamously suffered a horrific crash at the Nürburgring during the 1976 German Grand Prix, however, he went on to win the championship the very next year and won the championship again in 1984 (albeit neither seasons included the Nordschleife). Up and coming Brazilian driver Ayrton Senna won the 1984 Race of Champions at the Nürburgring and along with it achieved immediate peer and racing-legend attention. Seven-time Formula One World Champion Michael Schumacher won five German Grand Prix at the track, and who can forget the 'Queen of the Nurburgring' Sabine Schmitz's 10 minute race lap of the circuit in a Transit van for BBC's Top Gear showl

With almost a century of racing history under its belt, and bearing witness to some of the most memorable race meets ever, including the fierce battle between James Hunt and Niki Lauda, and Alain Prost winning the '84 Euro Grand Prix (the first F1 race there since '76), the Nürburgring has not only played an essential role in the development of motorsport, but also provided a thrilling and captivating watch for trackside spectators and armchair viewers alike.

And finally, for those that are keen, this iconic track is also accessible to the public. But a word of caution, if you are planning on heading there we suggest you take extreme care, with its 170+ corners and dubious safety record, the Nürburgring is quite literally the definition of a 'bucket-list' racetrack.



"It is definitely fun to figure out what the machine actually is doing just from the drawings. Looming cables and having them all tied nicely together in a beautiful bundlevery satisfying."



Campbell Burnes on Rugby **YSPARENCY** Former Manu Samoa No 10 and freelance rugby scribe Campbell Burnes argues that the All Blacks rest protocols during Super Rugby needed to be better signposted.

N o one could quite work it out. In theory, few can argue that you cannot flog All Blacks during Super Rugby Pacific in a Rugby World Cup year when we need them to be still standing by October. That was the premise behind the infamous reconditioning programme in Super Rugby ahead of the 2007 World Cup. That much maligned strategy saw 22 All Blacks removed from the first seven weeks of Super Rugby. Understandably, the franchise coaches found it hard to stomach, favouring a less prescriptive approach to resting their stars.

Each RWC year has seen rest protocols in place by the All Blacks coaches. But the difference in 2007 was that the strategy was clearly signposted and publicised.

This year, the All Blacks put the onus on the Super Rugby coaches to convey the protocols to media and the fanbase. Naturally confusion reigned and messages were mixed. It was thought that no player on the All Blacks rest list could play more than five games in a row. That included being in the match-day 23. Byes and injuries clouded the issue.


But we were not even told who all the players subject to the rest were. Blues coach Leon MacDonald volunteered to me that Mark Telea was on the list, but Patrick Tuipulotu was not. Okay, but why was Billy Harmon on the list when he had never played for the

All Blacks? Why was this not based on minutes as opposed to matches?

There was a minor hubbub when the Crusaders apparently needed dispensation to play Scott Barrett for a sixth straight game to alleviate a locking crisis. But there were several anomalies throughout the season, which went unremarked.

Richie Mo'unga played eight straight games. Fans would have enjoyed seeing more of Mo'unga as he will not be in the comp in 2024, but where was the consistency?

At the Blues, Stephen Perofeta and Hoskins Sotutu both played six games in a row, while Ofa Tuungafasi appeared in seven straight games. No one seemed to care. Were some players assessed on a case by case basis? What about the playoffs?



At the Hurricanes, Jordie Barrett and Tyrel Lomax played six straight, but Ardie Savea never more than the requisite five. At the Highlanders, Ethan de Groot played eight straight but Aaron Smith and Harmon never more than five.

Super Rugby coaches had to be strategic in how and how many they rested. As a rule, you should always play your strongest, or stronger, team at home. You owe it to the fans, who were hardly turning out in droves during the 2023 competition. You cannot control what your opposition does, especially if they are playing at home. Maybe the Chiefs did it better than most, removing their All Blacks at the same time for two matches, though they paid for it against the Reds in New Plymouth.

It's a real challenge for coaches whose KPIs are based around winning. We know there is a bigger picture in play and that is the All Blacks winning the Rugby World Cup.

But there must be a better way to do this, and there certainly needs to be better communication from the top.

Samisoni Taukei'aho was involved in 10 straight games for the Chiefs in 2023, despite the All Blacks rest protocols.




THERE'S PINK WATERMELON SNOW THAT HAS A SWEET SMELL AND TASTE.
