Campbell Burnes on Rugby DIARISE OGTOBER 15-16

Former Manu Samoa No 10 and freelance rugby scribe Campbell Burnes argues that the fate of the Rugby World Cup may rest on quarter-finals Nos 2 and 4.

t's a big weekend in New Zealand from October 14-15.

On the Saturday we have the general election, followed hours later by the second of the quarter-finals, which is the winner of Pool B (likely South Africa or Ireland, sorry, Scotland fans) versus the runner-up in Pool A. If the All Blacks lose their RWC opener against France and thus drop their game ever in the RWC pool stages, that will be them. That kickoff is at 8am on Sunday October 15 NZT.

However, if they win that opener against France and thus top Pool A, the All Blacks will play the following day (8am, Monday October 16 NZT) against (likely) either Ireland or South Africa. Either way, two of the best four teams in the world will be exiting the World Cup stage left two weeks before the climax. That is a shame in the extreme.

This scribe would love a tenner for every time someone has asked me how the World Cup will go in France. I invariably reply that it all hinges on that quarter-final weekend. The winners of quarter-finals No 2 and 4 could easily go all the way to the final, where the All Blacks versus France is not beyond the realms of possibility. On the weaker side of the draw, an England or Australia or Argentina could quite conceivably reach the final without over-exerting themselves.

The All Blacks' early form in July would suggest that they are more than capable of rising to the challenge of Ireland or South Africa, especially as the Irish have an unhealthy reliance on the fitness of Johnny Sexton, who was still, at the time of writing, making his way back from another injury.

Les Bleus of France may well justify the favourite tag. Mentally flaky and ill-disciplined too often in the past, they now look a galvanised, cohesive group under coach Fabien Galthié, with the world's best player, Antoine Dupont, pulling the strings in expert fashion. Even if they lose to the All Blacks on September 9, they are more than capable of winning their first title, and what a boon that would be for the game in France.

They already have the best Under 20s unit on the planet, their massive young pack helping trounce Ireland in July's world champs final. Their women are No 3 on the world rankings, but capable of moving on up. This could be the moment for France. But Les Bleus will, like the All Blacks, have to negotiate a tricky quarter-final against either Ireland or South Africa.

There are always many

variables in a World Cup. Many are worried that a red card for an accidental head clash will decide matters. That, too, could easily transpire. Untimely injuries will occur.

But one of the few things we can say with certainty is that this World Cup will hinge on two quarter-finals, where two very good teams will depart the event. Then it's all on. All Blacks fans, prepare for the highs and the lows. There will be nothing in between.



On the Eve of War:



Since its creation in 1886, it wasn't long before the idea of racing motor cars caught on. The first European races were held on public roads and would see the pioneering drivers of the day racing at speed between two main European capitals. These continued until the early 20th century, where the notorious Paris to Madrid race of 1903 saw the death of five drivers and spectators.

This led to the creation of the first ever Grand Prix in 1906. Held on a section of closed roads outside Le Mans, it saw the big manufacturers battle it out over two days on a specially designed circuit. The winner was Francois Sisz in a Renault.

In the years that followed, Grand Prix racing grew immensely in popularity. It became a source of national pride and saw England, France, Italy and Germany all competing for glory. One earlier

Grand Prix often described by motorsport historians as one of the greatest ever, took place at Lyon on July 4th 1914, only weeks before the outbreak of World War I.

Hosted by the L'Automobile Club de France, it was the 1914 French Grand Prix. Held over 7 hours and 753km of back-breaking roads through the French countryside, it was the biggest race of the Grand Prix season. France had already cemented itself as the hub of European motorsport and the dominant cars in the field were the Peugeots with their double overhead cam engines and four-wheel brakes.

Peugeot also had a strong team of drivers which included the great Georges Boillot. The moustachioed French racer already had many Grand Prix wins under his belt and many would expect him to have repeated success in his home Grand Prix. However, another manufacturer had other plans.

Mercedes had stayed out of Grand Prix racing since 1908 after a win in that year's French Grand Prix. Daimler-Benz management decided to focus on the production on aircraft engines instead. This field allowed the Germans to gain a unique understanding of lightweight materials and design. This is something which proved invaluable for readving a fleet of five cars for the 1914 Grand Prix season.


With the assassination of Austria-Hungary Archduke Franz Ferdinand occurring only a week before, and the potential for war breaking out between the European powers growing ever stronger, Daimler-Benz decided, for political reasons, that Mercedes must win the French Grand Prix that year.














The tool to do it was the Mercedes 18/100. It featured a 4.5L four-cylinder engine based on an aircraft design with four valves per cylinder. Each cylinder was built from forged steel instead of cast iron. Each 18/100 weighed in at 1100kg with power rated at 78kW and 283Nm of torque.

The 18/100 was also good for 112mph flat out. Mercedes, also keen to promote the German alliance with Austria-Hungary, stated their new car's crankshaft was built with high-grade Austrian steel. However, the Mercedes did not feature the same four-wheel brakes as the Peugeot. This would give Peugeot a tremendous advantage in the corners, but Mercedes had their star driver, Christian Lautenschlager. Having won the Grand Prix in 1908, Lautenschlager was highly skilled and would be a great asset.

At 8am on July 4th, 37 cars from six countries all took their place for the start. The 20 lap French Grand Prix got underway with two cars setting off at

30-second intervals. Boillot took an early lead, but the Mercedes of German, Max Sailer managed to pass him when the Frenchman pitted unexpectedly after the first hour.

Despite not having the edge in stopping

power, the Mercedes was just as composed in the corners and much quicker than the Peugeots on the straights. Sailer pushed hard and set a new lap record on the fourth lap. He was inexperienced and keen to show Lautenschlager he was capable in the seat. However, Sailer retired after pushing his car too hard on lap six. As a result of this, and the other hard-driven Mercedes of Theodore Pillette retiring as well, much of the field also dropped out due to pressure from the Germans. Some claim team Mercedes used these two as "rabbit" cars to break the field, but all involved on the day have denied this was the case.

That said, Mercedes ran their team with military-like precision. They knew exactly where each car was in the race at any



given time. As more cars dropped out to due to mechanical problems, Mercedes slowly moved their faster cars up into position.

Boillot in his Peugeot managed to keep a commanding lead until the 12th lap where Lautenschlager in his Mercedes managed to pass him. The lead was now see-sawing between Lautenschlager and Boillot. The crowds went ballistic every time they passed the start/finish line, as the end of each lap saw a different leader.

After a heroic drive, Boillot over revved his Peugeot and retired with just two laps to go. He sat on the side of the road weeping. With the pressure from Peugeot off, Lautenschlager eased off and led two other Mercedes to an historic 1-2-3 victory. Peugeot and the 300,000 French fans were utterly stunned.

Mercedes had emerged triumphant. However, just three weeks after their win, Europe was plunged into conflict. The First World War had begun.

Christian Lautenschlager's winning Mercedes 18/100 still exists today in the hands of a private collector. Lautenschlager would return to racing in the years after World War One. He even drove for Mercedes in the Indy 500, but with limited success. Boillot served as a fighter pilot during the war. Sadly, he was tragically killed in 1916 after being shot down over Verdun.

Mercedes would go on to turn Grand Prix racing upside down in the 1930s. However, their exploits with fellow German team Auto Union are for another story entirely.

his tip will improve your ball striking and also stop the dreaded 'over the top' downswing move that produces unwanted slices, pulls and overly chunky divots.

The great thing about this practice drill is that it you can work on it regularly at home - no golf club or golf ball is required.

- Take your posture inside a door jam/ frame with your imaginary golf club- as shown in pic 1.
- Ensure that the top of your forehead is just resting against the frame and that your hands hang to leave about 6 to 8 inches space to the inside of the frame.
- Make a slow smooth and deliberate backswing ensuring that your head stays in contact with the frame as it does at set-up. If you 'sway' on your backswing, you will struggle to do this. However, if you rotate your hips and shoulders correctly it will be easily achievable as in pic 2.
- A key reason that many players strike the golf ball inconsistently is due to them 'swaying' off the golf ball during the

- backswing instead of 'staying-centered' over the ball.
- Initiate your downswing move with a slight compression of your bodyweight into the left foot at the same time as rotating your left hip anti-clockwise this should bring your arms down on the same plane/path as that of the backswing and will deliver the hands to reach the doorframe in the same position that they were at set-up. See pic 3 = correct position leading into impact.
- Pic 4 is INCORRECT it shows what happens with an 'over the top move' when the upper body arms/hands/ shoulders have initiated the downswing 'over the top'- in pic 4 you will see that hips have remained static and haven't rotated - my hands have stayed high and have moved outside of the doorframe slamming my left wrist into the woodwork (I firmly suggest performing this drill slowly until it feels natural -bashing the doorframe is painful!)
- Make backswings and downswings repeatedly for 2 minutes twice a day. Ensure that you don't sway on the backswing and be sure to stop when your hands are level with the frame on the downswing. Your head position will move once your hands have delivered the imaginary club onto the ball so DON'T try to complete the downswing keeping your head in contact with the frame.



American cheddar cheese slices **Burger Buns Bread & Butter Pickles** Red onion

Smash burgers (smashies) are simply put, 100% ground beef mince (This mix is important - 80% lean, 20% fat) smashed thinly with a weighted burger press on to a searing hotplate, seasoned, flipped, topped with American cheddar cheese, served on a lightly toasted burger bun with American mustard, tomato sauce, burger sauce, pickles and thin slices of red onion. A quick, delicious crowd pleaser!

Time: 30mins

EOUIPMENT:

Scales

Burger press Metal spatula BBQ hot plate

INGREDIENTS:

Course ground burger mince (80% lean, 20% fat) Salt, pepper, garlic (SPG) rub

METHOD:

American mustard

Tomato sauce

Burger sauce

- Create 100g balls from the mince
- Heat the hot plate to 290c (550f)
- Place mince balls directly on to the hotplate and with your burger press apply plenty of downward pressure to "smash" the balls in to a thin-as-possible pattie, twist the burger press a 1/4 turn and slide the press off the pattie.
- Season raw side of the pattie with SPG.
- After just a few minutes, when the edges of the patties begin to lift, flip and add cheese slices.
- Another minute or so and it should be done! simple as that.
- Add the patties (singles, doubles or more) to the base of the burger bun and build your burger to suit.

Purist smash-burger aficionados subscribe to the less-is-more theory and use only the ingredients listed above, but there are no rules - add an egg & bacon for a breakfast treat or perhaps add shredded iceberg lettuce for a "big mac" clone.

The reason that smashies taste so good given their simplicity is due to the right amount of heat and the downward pressure that is applied when creating the pattie. This action kickstarts a process known as The Maillard Reaction. The science behind The Maillard Reaction states that the natural sugars and amino acids found in the beef undergo a chemical transformation that gives the smashed pattie it's distinctive golden brown crust and also instantly caramelises the sugars. So they not only look appealing but hits the tastebuds in an agreeable way. The Maillard Reaction is found to occur in many foods that we enjoy, such as a perfectly seared steak, baked breads, biscuits and toasted marshmellow as just a few examples. 🗷





ATT SUPPORTING WOMEN IN TRADES

At Apprenticeship Training Trust (ATT), we understand the importance of a diverse workforce, and this includes recognising the benefit of women working on the jobsite. Why? Because according to research from the United States, women bring unique qualities to the trades that support positive outcomes. In 2022, the National Center for Construction, Education and Research (NCCER) conducted a survey that backs these claims.

According to the survey these three key points were common positive threads:

Improved productivity: Through their attention to detail and their ability to follow established processes, women improve productivity. Their organisation skills come to the fore when it comes to taking care of materials and equipment and ensuring that cleanup after work is done. They also prioritise safety and are role model workers because they want to work safely.

Increased team performance and satisfaction: Women tend to show compassion to their co-workers, are engaging and lift morale. They are more likely to offer support and help bring teams together cohesively and concentrate on functioning at a high level as a team, rather than on individual achievement.

Leadership: The results of this research also showed that women are more likely to move into leadership positions because of their ability to encourage collaboration, prioritisation of safety, adherence to policy, and the pride they have in their work. A 2023 follow-up survey by Ambition Theory, supports this, claiming women want to be leaders and rank career advancement as important to them.

As active members of NAWIC (National Association of Women in Construction) ATT endorses the work being undertaken to encourage women to become tradespeople, by educating and breaking

down some of the barriers that deter them from entering this field of work.

One of our apprentices who is making great inroads to her electrical apprenticeship is Alice Rabbitts of Kinetic Electrical East Tamaki, a third year ATT electrical apprentice, who made the finalist list for the NAWIC Excellence Awards 2023. In the Apprentice Excellence category, Alice is one of seven apprentices from across Aotearoa New Zealand celebrated at a gala event in Christchurch in July.

Women make up around 50% of the New Zealand population, and yet less than 3% of construction tradespeople are women. 












It's fair to say that in general Motorsport is a world that thrives on speed, precision, and the pursuit of victory.

owever, amidst the roar of highperformance engines and the pursuit of podium finishes, there exists a unique and exhilarating form of motorsport that simply embraces chaos and destruction it's called the Demolition Derby.

Demolition Derby is a one-of-a-kind event that brings together fearless drivers and a sea of battered vehicles, captivating audiences with its adrenaline-fueled collisions and unpredictable outcomes - and as with many epic motorsport events, the origins of the demo derby are somewhat vague.

As various historical pictures will attest the sport's roots can be traced back to the American county fairs of the early 20th century, where it began life as a side attraction, however, it quickly gained popularity and subsequently became a 'thing'.

Most credit Don Basile with inventing and carrying out the very first demolition derby at Carrel Speedway in 1947, but this has also been challenged as the event was more of 'a race with secretly rigged cars that became disabled upon impact', opening the door for Larry Mendelsohn's Long Island event in the 50's to be credited too. Either way, the '60s saw the

derby begin to take a firm foothold across the States and it began spreading across other continents too with the likes of Australia enjoying the smashing spectacle. In fact it became so popular there that a 100 minute, 75-car event at Rowly Park Speedway, Adelaide in 1963 attracted over 20,000 spectators!

The 1970's were the golden years for the demo derby, with events being televised far and wide and hit TV shows such as 'Happy Days' making the less informed public more aware of the sport. Unfortunately, as quick as their rise was over that decade, the 80's saw their return to a more supportive role at both fairs and speedways, and since then, the media's love affair with the gladiatorial-style sport has been 'complicated', with regular signs of a resurgence mixed with several bouts of indifference.

New Zealand joined the 'Stockcar' party in 1954, with its first-ever race held at Aranui Speedway in Christchurch being influenced by the USA's Jalopy racing and Demolition Derbies of the time. Working in with the Stockcar/Speedway meets, the smash 'em up derbies emerged as local crowd-pleasers from the early 60's onwards, and NZ's very own Ellesmere

Motor Racing Club held New Zealand's first ever Caravan Demolition Derby, which featured on various television channels around the world.

While the Demolition Derby may appear to be a free-for-all automotive brawl, it follows a set of rules to ensure driver safety and fair competition. The exact regulations can vary depending on the event and location, but certain rules apply universally. Drivers must remove all glass, flammable materials, and loose objects from their vehicles before competing and roll bars and a full-harness seat belt (4-5 point), are mandatory to protect drivers from the intense impacts. (In NZ) Minimum age is 16, all competitors must hold either a Speedway NZ One-Day Derby Licence or a full SNZ licence and only have a maximum of 18 litres of petrol in the tank.

When it comes to the 'race' itself, the Demo Derby is the last race of the meet and the track surface is heavily watered to reduce vehicle speed. The intention is obviously to demolish the opponent's vehicles and those not competing in the spirit of this intention can be excluded avoiding hits is frowned upon. Cars can only move forward on the track and in an anticlockwise direction, (strictly within the confines of the track) and competitors are disqualified if driving on the infield unless the track is completely blocked. A competitor that is immobilised for more than ONE minute is deemed out of the Derby - and the winner is the last car standing/running.

It may not look like it from the outside, but the Demolition Derby requires strategic thinking from its participants. Experienced drivers employ different techniques to maximise their chances of survival and triumph. Some opt for a defensive approach, avoiding collisions and conserving their vehicles' functionality until the competition thins out - Boo. While others adopt an aggressive style, targeting opponents with calculated precision - Yay. However, luck often plays a significant role.

Derby events are held at speedway parks across the country and although the names, teams and vehicles may vary, the thrills and carnage remain just as smashing as when they first began. These events are a must-see experience right now, as with the global move towards EVs, Derbies are alas, something that won't be around forever.

IUBLING

New Zealand produces a profound number of beautiful IPAs, but if you keep hunting out bigger and better, the trail will inevitably lead into the realm of Double IPA.

ouble IPA also called Imperial IPA is, at its most basic, just that. Twice the malt and twice the hops for the same glass of beer, resulting in a powerfully flavourful (and powerfully strong) drop. In practice it gets a bit more complicated, as ratios don't scale so linearly as beer is brewed stronger. In fact the quantity of hops usually ends up well in excess of double in many cases.

These vastly hop dependent beers are exceptionally vulnerable to age and poor storage conditions, so always check the best before (or even better, the brewing date) and avoid anything that's getting long in the tooth, and if a can or bottle isn't being stored under chill then stay away. With quality control taken care of, here are a few of my recommendations that are available year round.

8 WIRED: Hopwired 7.3%abv

Hopwired is a legendary IPA in its own right, showing just how far New Zealand hops could be pushed way back in 2009. Including it here is maybe more of an honourable mention as it only refers to itself as mere single. But at a full 7.3%abv, it's actually stronger than a few other selfstated double IPA's out there.

GARAGE PROJECT: Pernicious Weed 8.0%abv

Another New Zealand hopped classic that unleashes the pungent gooseberry and passionfruit character of Nelson Sauvin hops. Keep an eye out for a rare version that appears after the yuzu harvest (usually around June) that's between brewed with

the peel of this exotic citrus, giving it extra lift and an exceptional sharp kick.

BEHEMOTH: Hops 8.0%abv

Behemoth understands IPA. Their number of one-off releases must be well over a hundred at this point. But they also understand the value of sticking to the basics. For this they have Hops, which very much does what it says on the can. What sets this one apart is the fact that it's sold in a six pack, which makes it the most affordable of its kind on the market.

EPIC: Hop Zombie 8.5%abv

Epic have always been pioneers in the use of American hops, and it's those firm flavours of pine resin and grapefruit that drive this long running release. If I'm in the

mood for strong IPA but I'm not feeling choosey, it's Hop Zombie's iconic red skull that I'll often

find myself reaching for. Also available in a four pack, albeit a pricey one.

LIBERTY: Citra 9.0%abv

A striking showcase of the rockstar American hop that it's named after, Citra is a lemon and grapefruit driven belter of an IPA, and a true double at a whopping 9%abv. It's significant malt richness is balanced by a massively bitter bite, measured at 99 international bitterness units (or IBUs). Heineken, as a point of comparison, clocks in at 19 IBUs.
