LIVING AS DISCIPLES OF ONE LORD

- How can our obedience to Jesus be both a private act of faith and a public witness to others?
- The teaching mentioned learning from one another in community. How have you seen “iron sharpening iron” happen in your life or group experiences?

DEEPER QUESTION

Jesus' lordship gives freedom from sin and assurance of His guidance. How does trusting Him as Lord change the way you respond to uncertainty, failure, or setbacks?
