The Scope:

STAHL Cranes was awarded the tender to install the Coal yard a Single Girder Crane in the existing Coal yard Bunker at RBMR. The Project was executed within a Brown field environment. Major changes in the scope developed, the Original scope called for all coal to be removed before commencement of works, but this did not materialized as the Plant boilers had to run at full capacity. The Project had to be re planned accordingly, meaning a revised methodology a revised histogram and a revised schedule. As for plant maintenance, the existing services as Cherri Pickers, cranage supply as well as available Operators was not freely available and this had to be mitigated on a daily basis to ensure "On Going and effective construction and Progress". Within all these challenges, STAHL had to plan and keep the momentum going. In addition, Safety compliance & Quality compliance was done with Commitment and Excellence. I can add to this, that COVID 19 had an impact on the Project in terms of momentum, but STAHL managed this conditions very well.

- All:" Day to Day"-Documentations was on time and all Data Packs was updated and ready for Handover;
- All "End of Job" Requirements in terms of Operational Spares and Training Material was submitted with in Time.

Technical

Within the project there was Various Technical Challenges. Within STAHL's technical team, Technical Queries was discussed and resolved on Time. It must be noted, that communication



lines was followed and that all Project Stakeholder was at all-time aware of the technical challenges and Proposed Solutions.
