### To Whom It May Concern

This letter serves to confirm that Stahl Cranes & Hoists (Pty) Ltd performed work for Sasol Synfuels in Secunda.

The project entailed the de-commissioning of a 10,5t overhead crane installed in 1992 and the replacement of the entire crane unit complete with grab with an upgraded 20t system to address the current production requirements.

The crane is located in a Zone 2 & 22 Area in terms of Hazardous Area Classification. The unit therefore required dual certification in order to comply with HAC requirements.

The crane is used in a production environment and can therefore not be de-commissioned at any given time. Only the annual Sasol Production Shutdown allowed for such an opportunity.

As a result, the project was a race against time to design, procure, manufacture, test, transport to site, erect and commission the crane in time for shutdown window.

*Stahl has proven to be up to the challenge and made this project a success within the extremely tight time frames required by this project.*
