First Communion Year 2 – Requirements

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Thank you for allowing us to be part of your child's faith formation journey. We have developed the following as a way for us to effectively communicate our program's expectations for this year. Please read each program requirement carefully prior to filling out the online registration form.

REGISTRATION

- Registration fees are due at the time of registration (\$175). Please talk to us about a payment plan if needed.
- Parents must provide a copy of each student's Baptismal certificate, or birth certificate if the child has not yet been Baptized.
- Parents must provide a recent photo of the catechumen.

The faith formation team at Our Lady of Guadalupe is here to support the parents in fulfilling their role as the primary educators of their children. Ultimately, the parents are responsible for the formation of their children. We will invite all parents to meet with one of our faith formation team members throughout the course of the year. This meeting is for us to get to know one another better!

We use a program called Pathways for our faith formation. Pathways is focused on the formation of the entire family.

FAITH FORMATION YEAR 2 (FC 2) HAS TWO PARTS. (MATERIALS WILL BE PROVIDED)

- Mend – Parents are invited to reflect on their experience of Reconciliation and equip them to teach, share faith, and pray with their children. Families will encounter Jesus and experience the beauty of Reconciliation through hands-on activities and meaningful conversations.
- Nourish – Parents will be equipped to teach, share faith, and pray with their children as they discover how the Mass relates to daily life. Families will encounter Jesus and experience the beauty of the Eucharist through a variety of hands-on activities and meaningful conversations.

Family Participation:

- Please note that Faith Formation Year 2 (FC 2) is a program that requires the parents to participate in their own session in the Coleman Center while children have their sessions in class. At the end of the class, the children will be taken to Coleman Center to meet with you.
- In between classes, families will be given activities or "at home sessions" to complete together!

- o To show us that you've completed an activity, please take pictures of each assignment and participants. Don't hesitate to be creative.
- o Each activity is to be completed by the entire family.

ATTENDANCE

- To provide families with meaningful opportunities to learn, grow, and spend time together, our program meets on a limited schedule throughout the year. Because of this, students and parents are allowed a maximum of **three absences**. We understand that unexpected circumstances can arise. If your family experiences an unforeseen situation, please contact me as soon as possible so we can discuss the appropriate course of action and determine how best to support your child.

MASS ATTENDANCE

- All Catholics have an obligation to attend Mass each Sunday (or Saturday evening) and holydays of obligation. As we live out our Catholic faith and prepare to receive the sacraments, it is important that we take this seriously!
 - o Days of Obligation this year, in the Diocese of Orange
 - Every Sunday (or Saturday evening)
 - March 28, Easter Sunday
 - November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints
 - December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception
 - December 25, the Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ

MASS SLIPS

- Mass slips will be provided for your child to complete. Each Mass slip includes a section for your child's prayer intention. This encourages your child to think of others and offer their prayers to God during Mass.
- These Mass slips serve two purposes:
 - o They encourage children to actively participate in the celebration of the Mass by reflecting on and offering personal prayer intentions.
 - o They provide a simple way to verify Mass attendance as part of the Faith Formation program requirements.
- Two collection boxes are available for completed Mass slips. One is located at the entrance of Jason's Plaza, near the fountain, and the other is on the opposite side of the plaza, near the vehicle exit.

REQUIRED PRAYERS

By the end of FC 2, all students must know and be able to pray the following:

- The Sign of the Cross
- The Lord's Prayer (Our Father)
- The Hail Mary
- The Glory Be
- The Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel
- The Act of Contrition

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- One parent/guardian and student must attend the First Reconciliation Service with the child.

- During the first Communion Mass, all children will sit together by themselves, with catechists for supervision.
