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First Communion Year 2 Children's Requirements

MASS ATTENDANCE

- All Catholics have an obligation to attend Mass each Sunday (or Saturday evening) and holydays of obligation. As we live out our Catholic faith and prepare to receive the sacraments, it is important that we take this seriously!
- To let us know your family went to Mass, there will be a form to fill out online!

CLASSES

- Children preparing for First Communion must attend two years of classes to receive formation about the Catholic faith and life in Christ, Confession, and the Eucharist. During class, it is important that children are respectful, pay attention, and are not on their phones.

FAMILY ADORATION

- Children preparing to receive First Communion must attend at least 2 Family Adoration evenings with their parents during the course of the faith formation year (September - May)
- Family Adoration takes place on the third Wednesday of every month from 5pm - 7pm. (Registration required)
- Family Adoration is an opportunity for young families to come together in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We will guide your family in praying for an hour in the Church, and then we will do an activity together!
- This is a great opportunity to pray together as a family, and to grow in community with other young families at OLG.

PRAYERS

- Children will learn the following prayers by the end of Year 1: Sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Guardian Angel, Act of Contrition, St. Michael Prayer.
- We will practice and check in on them during class, but in order for kids to memorize the prayers it is crucial that they pray it at home with their family!

FIRST RECONCILIATION

- Prior to receiving first Holy Communion, children must go to Confession. The date for the first Reconciliation service is on Monday, May 14.

KNOWLEDGE OF THE EUCHARIST

- In order to receive the Eucharist, it is crucial that the children understand that the Eucharist is truly the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord. Catechists will check in with the children in this regard throughout the year.

ABSENCE POLICY

- Children are allowed up to 3 absences. Please let us know in advance if your child will be absent by emailing faithformation@olglahabra.org
- Since there are only 11 classes, when a child is absent, they will need to make up the class. Make up options include Be Light (parents and children required to attend. marriage evening for parents with children formation concurrently) and Family Adoration (parents and children required to attend)
