## Signature Cocktails

### **The Ace Margarita**

*"Served with a salt rim and smash power."*

Tequila, lime, triple sec, agave.

### **The Hole-in-Fun Mule**

*"A zesty drive that finishes smooth."*

Vodka, ginger beer, lime, mint.

### **Smash & Dash (Tequila Sunrise Twist)**

*"Colorful, bold, and always a winning serve."*

Tequila, OJ, grenadine, fresh lime.

### **The Double Fault (Long Island Iced Tea)**

*"Dangerously strong. You've been warned."*

Vodka, rum, gin, tequila, triple sec, sour, cola.

### **The Clubhouse Cooler (Mojito Twist)**

*"Minty fresh with a laid-back backhand."*

Rum, mint, lime, soda water, touch of cucumber.

### **The Paddle Punch (Fruity Rum Punch)**

*"Tropical chaos in a glass—like a rally gone wild."*

Light & dark rum, pineapple, orange, grenadine.

### **The Birdie Old Fashioned**

*"Strong, smooth, and classic—like a single-digit handicap."*

Bourbon, bitters, sugar, orange zest.

### **The Royal Smash**

*"A fresh, bold twist on a whiskey smash fit for a king after a long set or round."*

Bourbon, muddled mint, lemon, blackberry, simple syrup





### **Queen's Court Cosmo**

*"Elegant and refined with just the right amount of flair—like a smooth backhand volley."*

Vodka, triple sec, cranberry, lime juice, elderflower

### **Ace Paloma**

*"Served with a winning spin, this cocktail celebrates every victorious point on the padel court."*

Tequila blanco, grapefruit soda, lime, agave syrup, tajín rim

### **Back Nine Breeze**

*"Light and refreshing—perfect for cooling down after a virtual golf session."*

Gin, cucumber, mint, lemon, tonic water

### **El Rey Old Fashioned**

*"A Tex-Mex royal spin on the classic, smooth and commanding."*

Reposado tequila, agave, bitters, orange peel

### **King's Swing**

*"Tropical and smooth with a hidden punch—this one goes down easy but hits hard."*

Spiced rum, pineapple, lime, coconut cream

### **Bloody Mary**

*Especially popular during brunch games or early kickoffs.*

Vodka, tomato juice, spices, and garnishes.

### **Whiskey Sour**

*Tart and smooth, a go-to for whiskey lovers.*

Whiskey, lemon juice, simple syrup.

### **Gin & Tonic**

*Light and crisp—especially popular in warm climates.*

Gin and tonic water, usually with lime.





### **Carajillo del Rey**

*“A bold blend to awaken the senses.”*

Licor 43 and espresso shaken over ice, served in a rocks glass with a twist of citrus or dusted with cinnamon—fit for a knight’s nightcap.



## **Royal Classics (With a Twist)**

### **Noble Negroni**

*“Bold, bitter, and balanced—like a master tactician on the court.”*

Gin, sweet vermouth, Campari, orange bitters, smoked orange slice

### **Majestic Mule**

*“A fiery kick wrapped in a copper crown.”*

Vodka, lime, ginger beer, muddled jalapeño, mint

### **Duke’s Espresso Martini**

*“For those who rule the night—energizing, creamy, and decadent.”*

Vodka, coffee liqueur, espresso, vanilla syrup

### **The Green Jacket**

*“A nod to golf’s highest honor—fresh, bright, and undeniably smooth.”*

Melon liqueur, vodka, lemon juice, club soda



## **Royal Mocktails (Zero-Proof)**

### **The Scepter**

*“Crisp and clean with a regal touch.”*

Cucumber, lime, mint, soda, honey syrup

### **Crown Cooler**

*“A tropical throne of refreshment with zero guilt.”*

Pineapple, coconut, lime, sparkling water

Citrus soda, grenadine, orange wedge.

### The Match Point Mule

Ginger beer, mint, lime, soda.

Half lemonade, half iced tea.

### Padel Paloma Zero

*"Tangy and refreshing with no tequila on board."*
